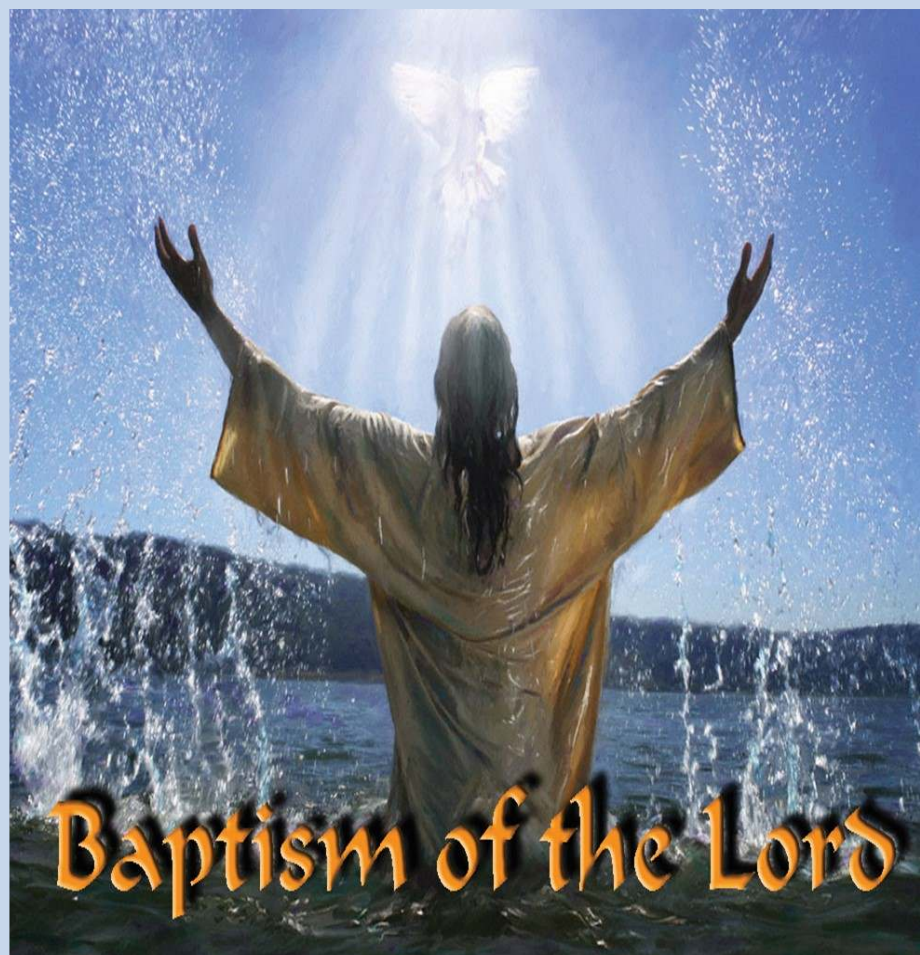

## Jubilee of Hope

This year, 2025, has been designated as a special Jubilee Year by Pope Francis. The theme of this jubilee is “Pilgrims of Hope”. We are encouraged during this time to reflect on the virtue of hope and to witness to our hope in the world. According to the Catechism, Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ’s promises and relying not on our strength, but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit. Hope is much more than a wish or optimism. Hope is a desire for eternal happiness. This theological virtue is a gift from God that sustains and motivates us and fuels our perseverance because hope places heaven as the ultimate goal. Hope is the trust in God - that He is with us now and will always be.

Pilgrimage is a fundamental element of every Jubilee event. Setting out on a journey is traditionally associated with our human quest for meaning in life. While you may not be able to travel to Rome to talk through the Holy Door and receive a plenary indulgence, there are still many opportunities to receive the special jubilee indulgence and blessings locally. Here are some of the ways that you can gain the special jubilee plenary indulgence:

- Make a pilgrimage to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Camden and participate at Mass, or pray before the Blessed Sacrament for a time, or pray the Holy Rosary.
- Visit, for an appropriate amount of time, you brothers and sisters who are in need or in difficulty (the sick, prisoners, lonely elderly people, disabled people...), in a sense making a pilgrimage to Christ present in them (cf. Mt 25, 34-36).
- In the spirit of penance, abstain at least for one day of the week from futile distractions (real but also virtual distractions, for example, the use of the media and/or social networks), or from superfluous consumption (for example by fasting or practicing abstinence according to the general norms of the Church),
- Donating a proportionate sum of money to the poor; by supporting works of a religious or social nature, especially in support of the defense and protection of life in all its phases, but also by supporting the quality of life of abandoned children, young people in difficulty, the needy or lonely elderly people, or migrants from various countries.
- Dedicating a reasonable portion of one’s free time to voluntary activities that are of service to the community or to other similar forms of personal commitment.

You can see that there are a variety of opportunities to receive the special Jubilee plenary indulgence. Remember that a plenary indulgence is a very powerful spiritual gift. In Catholic theology, an indulgence is a remission of temporal punishment due to sins that have already been forgiven through the sacrament of confession. Plenary indulgences go beyond partial remissions and offer complete purification, wiping away all temporal punishment for past sins, making the soul as pure as a newly baptized infant. You may receive one plenary indulgence per day. They can also be offered for a loved one in purgatory, granting immediate entrance into heaven.

To obtain a plenary indulgence, one must fulfill the following conditions:

- Perform the work or activity associated with the indulgence (like those mentioned above).
- Have the intention to gain the indulgence and be in the state of grace.
- Go to Confession (one confession is good for several indulgences, about twenty days)
- Reception of the Holy Eucharist.
- Prayer for the Intentions of the Pope (usually an Our Father and a Hail Mary and a Glory Be)
- Detachment from Sin: Foster an inner detachment from all sin, even venial sins, with the firm resolve to avoid them in the future.

Go get your indulgences, and increase you Hope in God during this Jubilee Year!

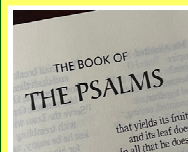

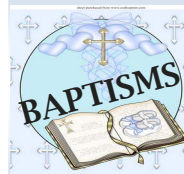


## Thank You so much

## Inspirational Ireland Itinerary

**Sunday, May 11th** - Depart Philadelphia to Dublin, Ireland.

**Monday, May 12th** - Arrive in Dublin and travel by coach to Galway. Lunch at the Johnstown Estate and Mass with the group. Dinner and overnight at the Salt Hill Hotel.

**Tuesday, May 13th** - Journey to the village of Knock. Celebrate Mass where the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John and the Lamb appear on the gable wall of the parish church. Then return to Galway for a relaxing cruise onboard the Corrib Princess on Lough Corrib. Dinner back at the Salt Hill hotel.

**Wednesday, May 14th** - Begin the day with Mass at Galway Cathedral then onto Caherconnell Fort & Sheepdog trials. Enjoy the great skills of the shepherds as they work the collies in a demonstration. After a stop at the quaint village of Adare, we arrive in Killarney for a 2-night stay and dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

**Thursday, May 15th** - Enjoy a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through Killarney National Park to Ross Castle. Then onto the Gap of Dunloe for some shopping at Moriarty's Gift Store. Dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

**Friday, May 16th** - After Mass we visit Blarney Castle to kiss the Blarney Stone and shopping at the Blarney Woolen Mills. From there we travel to the Cobb Heritage Center, the last port of call to board the RMS Titanic. Dinner and overnight in Cork at the River Lee Hotel.

**Saturday, May 17th** - After Mass we will view the Rock of Cashel and travel onwards to the National Stud for a private tour where Ireland's best racehorses are bred. Onto Enfield Co. Meath for dinner and overnight at the Johnstown House Estate.

**Sunday, May 18th** - After Mass we will sightsee on the famous green Hop On Hop Off tour bus, visiting the Guinness Store house. The EPIC Museum in Dublin is our final stop. Then onto the Johnstown House Estate for a farewell dinner and overnight.

**Monday, May 19th** - We depart Dublin for our return trip to Philadelphia.

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

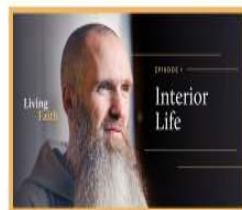
