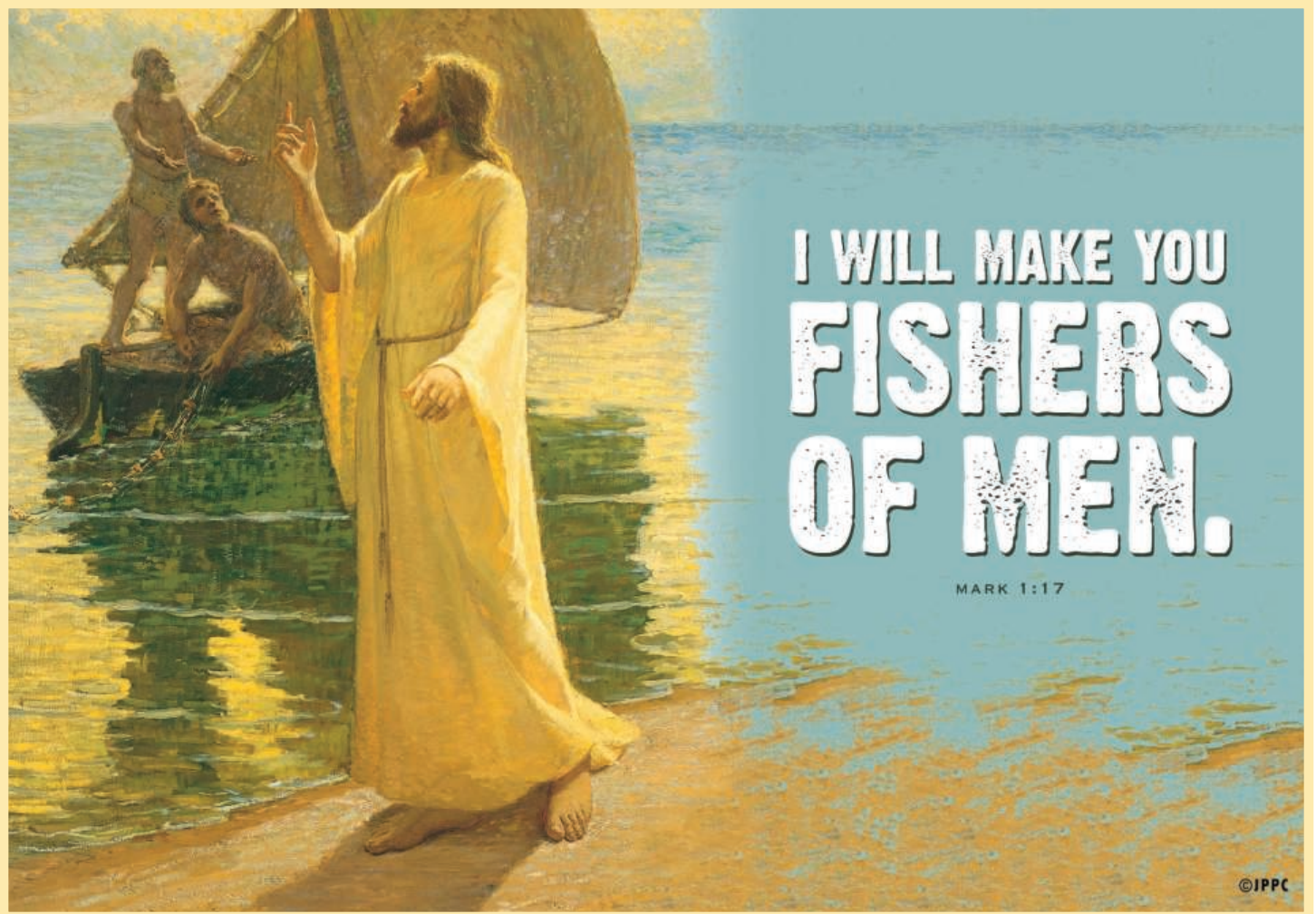

## On Blessings

The recent document on blessings, *Fiducia Supplicans*, strangely issued right before Christmas (December 18) by the Vatican's Dicastery of the Doctrine of the Faith (DDF) has caused a lot of confusion both in the secular world and in the Church. And the odd follow up clarification on January 4 by the DDF didn't do much to help. I thought I would throw my hat into the ring and give my take on these documents and what they mean for us.

Like most Church documents, the actual text of the document itself can often be quite different than what is reported by media outlets, regardless of their political or theological perspective. The most common headline that followed the declaration is that the Catholic Church now blesses gay couples. That's why it is always important to take the time to read the document itself so one can see what it says, rather than what some agenda driven media person says it says.

*Fiducia Supplicans* claims to offer a helpful pastoral perspective on the nature and meaning of blessings. And I would say that it does a pretty decent job explaining the different categories of blessings. The most important point is the critical distinction made between a formal, official, liturgical blessing of the Church and an informal blessing. The easy way of looking at this is, say, the blessing of the Advent wreath. This official, liturgical blessing takes place during the First Sunday of Advent, at Mass, at a certain time in the Mass and with specific words from a specific liturgical text. Compare this to a student coming up to a priest after mass and asking for an informal blessing before a big exam the next day. The first is an "official" "liturgical" blessing, while the second is "spontaneous" and "informal". While this is an accurate distinction and, I suppose can be helpful, I do not understand why there needs to be a document on it. Priests can always informally bless a lot of things and people. It begins to get very confusing, however, when *Fiducia Supplicans* introduces irregularly married couples (not married in the Church) and homosexual "couples".

It's important to note that both *Fiducia Supplicans* and the "clarification" both state clearly and firmly that marriage is only between a man and a woman. Both documents state that no formal blessing may be given to an irregularly married couple or to a homosexual "couple" nor can the priest wear any liturgical vestments nor can it take place in a church. In a strange note, the "clarification" goes so far to say that this informal blessing is to last "10 or 15 seconds". Both documents also state that this non-liturgical blessing cannot and does not in any way ratify or justify anything immoral. The "clarification" puts it this way, "*This non-ritualized form of blessing, with the simplicity and brevity of its form, does not intend to justify anything that is not morally acceptable. Obviously, it is not a marriage, but equally it is not an "approval" or ratification of anything either.*" The "clarification" also states the following, "*In order to avoid any doubt, the Declaration adds that, when the blessing is requested by a couple in an irregular situation, «even though it is expressed outside the rites prescribed by the liturgical books, this blessing should never be imparted in concurrence with the ceremonies of a civil union, and not even in connection with them. Nor can it be performed with any clothing, gestures, or words that are proper to a wedding. The same applies when the blessing is requested by a same-sex couple» (n. 39). It remains clear, therefore, that the blessing must not take place in a prominent place within a sacred building, or in front of an altar, as this also would create confusion.*"

So you can see that both documents affirm that that the Church does not have the power to impart blessings on unions of persons of the same sex nor does the Church have the power to confer its liturgical blessing when that would somehow offer a form of moral legitimacy to a union that presumes to be a marriage or to an extra-marital sexual practice.

So practically, what it comes down to is this: the Church, in this case, its priests, cannot offer the Church's blessing to "homosexual" couples or to couples married outside of the Church. Priests can offer informal blessing to individuals who might happen to be in those situations. That's why this document seems to be unnecessary to me. Priests were always able to informally bless people. After all, isn't it good to ask God's blessing on people, especially on people who might be living contrary to the Gospel, so that they may receive extra grace to turn back to the Lord and repent of their sinfulness?

Let's reiterate. *Fiducia Supplicans* did not change anything. But it is confusing both in its timing and its design. And I think it opened up an opportunity for people, including some priests and bishops, to intentionally misinterpret this document to further an agenda that is contrary to the truth revealed to us by God. Let us pray that any ill effect of this may be minimized.

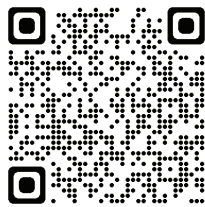

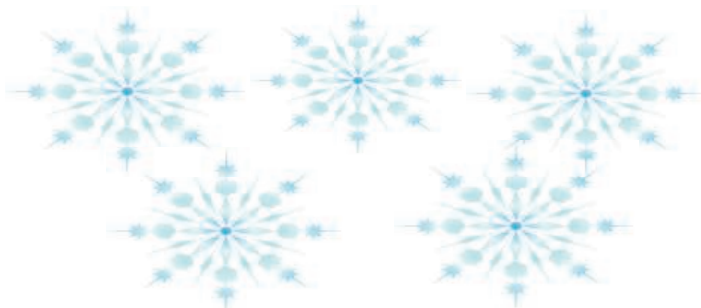
