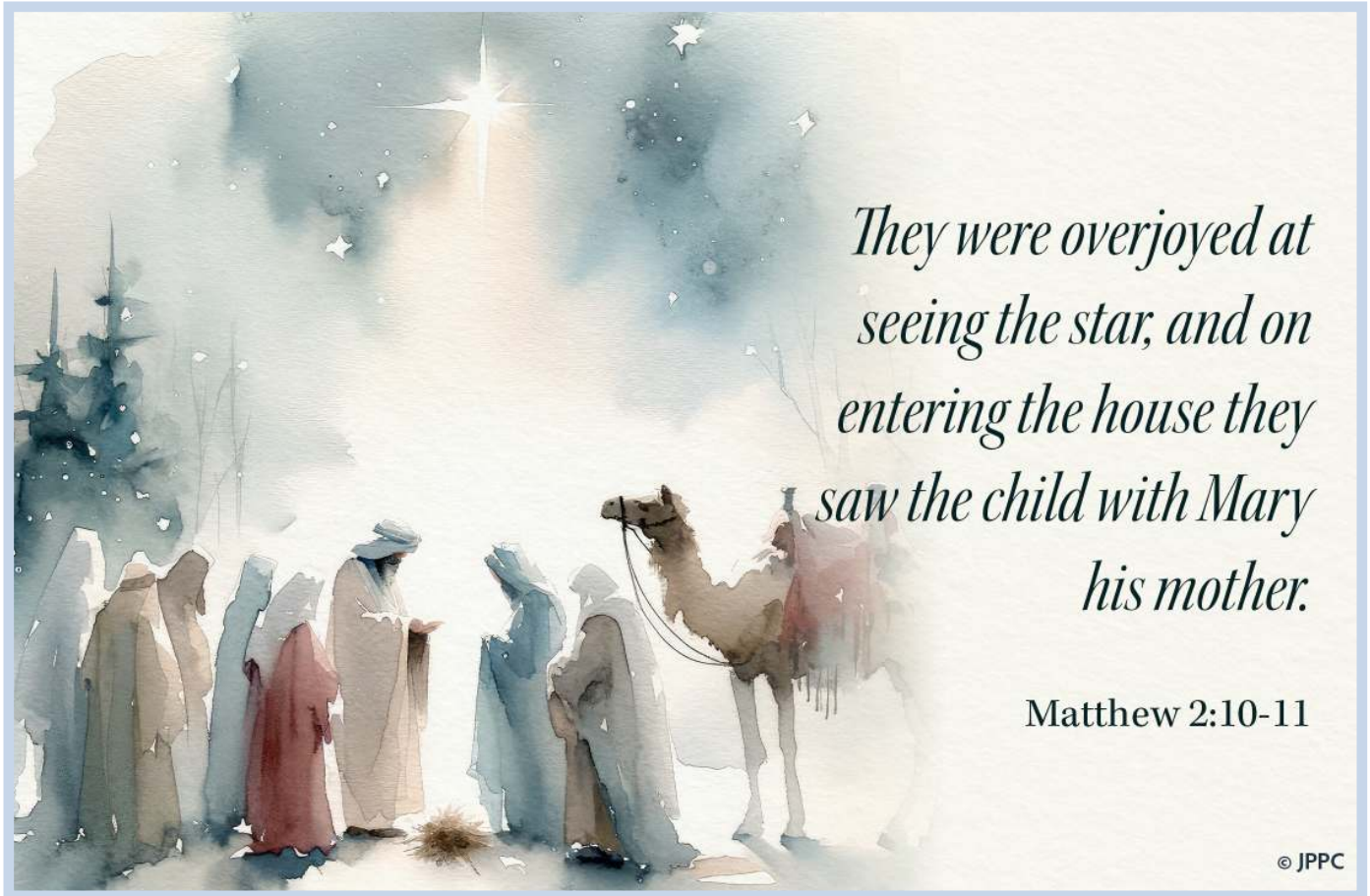

What is worship?

It is always good to reflect once and awhile on the question, “What do we do at Mass?” The answer is, to put it simply, we worship God. Even though in the end we receive much more (Jesus in Sacred Scripture and especially in the Holy Eucharist) than we can offer, we need to remember the main focus of the Mass still must be God and not us. The Sacrament of the Eucharist is called the “source and summit of the Christian life” by the Church. The Church teaches in the Catechism that, *“The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are orientated toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself.”* The Constitution of the Sacred Liturgy from the Second Vatican Council states, *“At the Last Supper, on the night when he was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood.”* At Mass, then, we participate in the one sacrifice of Christ’s gift of himself to the Father on our behalf. While Christ’s sacrifice was an event that happened in a particular moment in time, its effects transcend time. Through our participation at Mass, we experience the full power of the Lord’s passion death and resurrection. This is the Mass, this is our worship.

In the midst of such a miraculous event such as the Mass many things can happen that can cause us to focus less on Christ and more on ourselves: the homily can be boring, the microphone may not be turned up enough, one may not like a particular hymn, the crying child is distracting, a cell phone rings, people walking around at inopportune times, even our own personal issues going on in our lives. The list can go on and on. And on an individual level you might think that because of all of the distractions, you didn’t get much out of the Mass. Perhaps as you walk out of Mass, you don’t even have a particularly “spiritual” feeling. In all this there is one very, very important thing to remember. And I don’t think it can be stressed enough. Our worship, even with all of the distractions, is pleasing to God and honors him as long as we try to give him our very best at Mass. Therefore we need to be cautious about rating the spiritual value of our worship by the way we feel about it. The spiritual realm of the human person is not equal to the emotional realm. Although they are related and connected, they are not equal. For example, Jesus said, “If you love me follow my commandments.” How many times have we followed a commandment even though we didn’t want to? And yet it was something good and pleasing to the Lord, even though we didn’t “feel” like doing it. So too at Mass, we are here to offer God our best - and we can always succeed since when we offer ourselves completely at Mass. We connect ourselves to the most precious and glorious of offerings of all, Christ himself. And through this offering, this worship, we receive Divine grace into our souls that unite us to the Lord and help us to be transformed more into the likeness of Christ. All of which, we rarely “feel”, yet nonetheless is occurring in our souls.

So it is vital that during our worship our focus is the Lord. For our worship to be truly “God centered” and spiritually productive, all of our liturgical actions must reflect this idea. Coming to Mass a few minutes early, turning off our phone, asking the Lord to help us stay focused, explicitly offering ourselves to the Father in union with Jesus, really trying, despite the distractions to “pray” our way through Mass - these are the ways that we can increase what we get spiritually from Mass. Because the more aware we become that the focus of our participation at Mass is God, rather than ourselves; the more we will find that what we actually receive from God is greater than if the focus was ourselves. I wrote in the beginning of this article that we end up getting more than we give at Mass. But the only way that happens is if our focus is on God and not ourselves. So, if our focus is on coming to Mass to “get” Communion, we are going to miss out. On the other hand, if our focus is on offering ourselves with Christ in worship of the Father then we will have the best opportunity to receive what the Lord offers us at Mass, Himself.

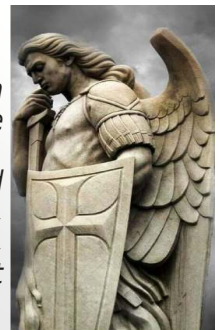

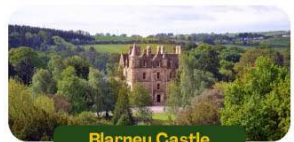

Tuesday, May 13th - Journey to the village of Knock. Celebrate Mass where the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John and the Lamb appear on the gable wall of the parish church. Then return to Galway for a relaxing cruise onboard the Corrib Princess on Lough Corrib. Dinner back at the Salt Hill hotel.

Wednesday, May 14th - Begin the day with Mass at Galway Cathedral then onto Caherconnell Fort & Sheepdog trials. Enjoy the great skills of the shepherds as they work the collies in a demonstration. After a stop at the quaint village of Adare, we arrive in Killarney for a 2-night stay and dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

Thursday, May 15th - Enjoy a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through Killarney National Park to Ross Castle. Then onto the Gap of Dunloe for some shopping at Moriarty's Gift Store. Dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

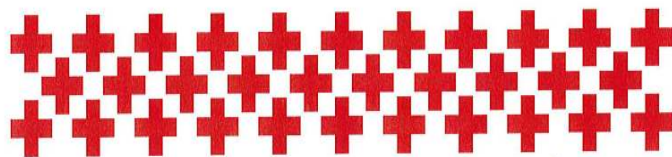

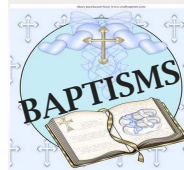

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.



OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

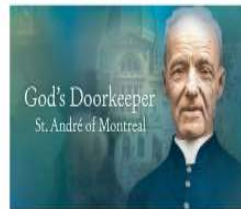
