THE MYSTERY OF OUR SOUL

One little article is not really sufficient to explain the mystery of the soul, the human person, and God's grace. I hope to offer some insight as to what we believe, according to the authentic teaching of the Church, and to spur you on to greater investigation, meditation, and prayer on this wonderful topic.

The immortal part of the human person, the soul, is a fascinating and mysterious part of who we are. It is our certain faith that human beings are created in the image of God, being at once body and soul. The Catechism states, [the] "soul"...refers to the innermost aspect of man, that which is of greatest value in him, that by which he is most especially in God's image: "soul" signifies the spiritual principle in man." This does not mean, however, that the body isn't important. The Catechism further says, "The human body shares in the dignity of "the image of God": it is a human body precisely because it is animated by a spiritual soul, and it is the whole human person that is intended to become, in the body of Christ, a temple of the Spirit."

Thus we have a unity of body and soul which makes up the human person. As the Catechism states, "the unity of soul and body is so profound that one has to consider the soul to be the "form" of the body: i.e., it is because of its spiritual soul that the body made of matter becomes a living, human body; spirit and matter, in man, are not two natures united, but rather their union forms a single nature."

But what about our emotions? Are they part of our bodies and souls? Don't we often "feel" close to God? Is that accurate? Are our emotions good or bad? It is often a great challenge for us to properly understand the role of our emotions. Often our feelings are attributed to our souls, but that is not really the case. Perhaps surprisingly, our faith teaches us that our emotions are "part" of our bodily nature. In the Catechism we read, "Feelings or passions are emotions or movements of the sensitive appetite that incline us to act or not to act in regard to something felt or imagined to be good or evil.....they form the passageway and ensure the connection between the life of the senses and the life of the mind." As the connection between our bodies and souls, our emotions are extremely important to us, but they are not the powers of our souls. Our emotions and passions motivate us to act in a certain way, good or evil, but they must always be filtered through our intellect and will (our soul) so that we choose what we know to be good and reject what we know to be evil, no matter how strongly we feel one way or the other. That is the challenge of holiness.

So, then, how can we "know" we are receiving God's grace if we can't feel it? When I come out of Mass feeling uplifted, isn't that God's grace? Part of a dialog between Pope Francis and an Italian atheist can illuminate this:

Scalfari: Do you feel touched by grace?

Pope Francis: No one can know that. Grace is not part of consciousness; it is the amount of light in our souls, not knowledge nor reason. Even you, without knowing it, could be touched by grace.

Scalfari: Without faith? A non-believer?

Pope Francis: Grace regards the soul.

Scalfari: I do not believe in the soul.

Pope Francis: You do not believe in it but you have one.

While feeling uplifted after Mass or prayer in a given instance may be a blessing from God, it is not an indication that we have received God's grace. Here again the Catechism teaches us, "Since it belongs to the supernatural order, grace escapes our experience and cannot be known except by faith. We cannot therefore rely on our feelings or our works to conclude that we are justified and saved. However, according to the Lord's words "Thus you will know them by their fruits" - reflection on God's blessings in our life and in the lives of the saints offers us a guarantee that grace is at work in us and spurs us on to an ever greater faith and an attitude of trustful poverty."

While we may not consciously perceive the reception of God's grace, there is no question that we can tell God is working within us. Much like love or life, neither of which we can actually see, yet we know they exist through the signs that they leave. We know love when we love and are loved, we know life when we live, and we know God's grace in active in us as we increase in faith and trust and love of God and our lives demonstrate that faith, trust, and love in God by the way we live them.

The collected money will go to the work of the Greater Woodbury Cooperative Ministry Food Pantry.

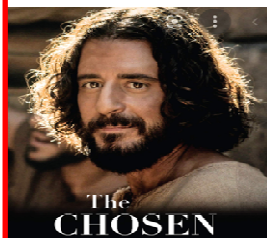
The shopping day is **Wednesday, October 20, 2021**. It is an **in-store only Pass**. Up to 25%, 15% and 10% is offered in various departments.

LIFE AND JUSTICE MINISTRY AT HOLY ANGELS

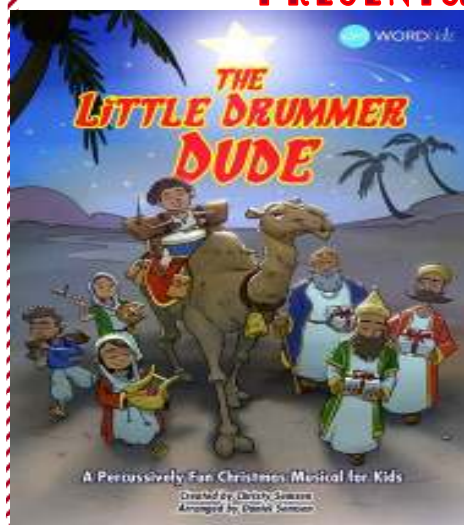

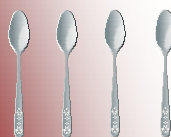
