Worship Center Update

A few people have asked me when Masses might begin again at the “Worship Center”. I have been thinking about this recently and have discussed it with the Parish Finance Council, the Parish Council, and the priests here at Holy Angels. Things have changed here over the past few months and I think it’s important to take everything into consideration when deciding what action to take.

As you know, due to the heating/air conditioning system problem, we moved in late May the 4:00PM Saturday Mass and the 11:30AM Sunday Mass from the Worship Center to St. Patrick’s and discontinued the 9:30AM Mass. During this same period, we lost Father Hugh and Father Jose but gained Father Gallagher. This resulted in one less priest to celebrate the parish Masses.

Looking at the Mass attendance numbers from before the move to now, they are virtually the same. This means that those who would normally go to the 9:30 Mass, are going to another here at the parish, splitting it seems, between the 10:00AM and the 11:30AM. The numbers for the 4:00PM are roughly the same. Our ordinary income, which is essentially the Sunday collection, is slightly above budget for the year, despite one less Mass.

While some people have asked when Mass is returning to the Worship Center, many, many more have said how much they like being at St. Patrick’s and also like the fuller church. Also, some of those who have asked about the Worship Center have said we shouldn’t go back because we don’t need it.

Even though the heating/air conditioning system is repaired, decreased use of the Worship Center certainly costs a lot less of the parish money. This is especially true with the current, very high energy costs.

Given all these factors, and after consulting the Parish Council, the Finance Council and the other priests of the parish, all of whom were unanimous in their agreement, I have decided that we will maintain the current Mass schedule as it is in both time and location. Should there be a resurgence of COVID or some other reason, we can easily reestablish Mass at the Worship Center. And for big holidays like Christmas and Easter, we will of course utilize the Worship Center for Mass. As we move forward, we will also explore ways to maximize the use of the Worship Center for the benefit of the whole parish. It is a valuable asset of our parish and should be utilized in the best way possible.
