## The Five Precepts of the Catholic Church

What does it mean to be a practicing Catholic? Depending on who is in the crowd discussing the question, a lot of different answers can be given. Are there some actual, objective criteria that can be used to answer the question? Or are we stuck giving subjective answers to such an important question? And if there are objective criteria that we can know and follow, then we can have a pretty good understanding about where we are in our relationship with the Church and with the Lord. Be certain of this; our relationship with the Lord and the Church are directly related. The Five Precepts of the Church have a long history in the Church and they are listed in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, paragraphs 2041-2043. They are, as the *Catechism* states, the “very necessary minimum” for what it means to be a practicing Catholic.

They are reproduced from the *Catechism* here:

**The precepts of the Church are set in the context of a moral life bound to and nourished by liturgical life. The obligatory character of these positive laws decreed by the pastoral authorities is meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor:**

**The first precept - "You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor"-** requires the faithful to sanctify the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord as well as the principal liturgical feasts honoring the mysteries of the Lord, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the saints; in the first place, by participating in the Eucharistic celebration, in which the Christian community is gathered, and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days.

**The second precept "You shall confess your sins at least once a year"** - ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness.

**The third precept "You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season"** - guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy.

**The fourth precept "You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church"** - ensures the times of self-discipline and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart.

**The fifth precept "You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church"** - means that the faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability.

The above precepts are, as the Church teaches us, the “very necessary minimum” for what it means to be a practicing Catholic. Therefore, being a practicing Catholic isn’t a subjective opinion; it’s not whether I think I am a practicing Catholic or not. There are objective criteria that determine whether one is a “practicing Catholic.” And truly, in the context of our normal everyday lives, the five precepts are not overly taxing in time or effort. At the same time they are substantial enough for us to realize that there is a minimum conscious commitment required if we are to remain connected to Jesus and his Church.
