The Two Headed Bird

Once upon a time there lived a Bharunda, a bird with two heads. One day it found a strange fruit on the seashore. It picked it up and started eating it. The head that was feeding, exclaimed, "Many a sweet fruit tossed by the sea have I eaten, but this beats them all! Is it the fruit of a sandalwood tree or that of the divine parijata?

Hearing this, the other head asked to taste the fruit, but the first head refused, saying selfishly, "We have a common stomach, so there's no need for you to eat it too." And the first head continued to enjoy the delicious fruit.

From that day on, the second head carried a grudge against the first and waited for an opportunity to take revenge. One day it found a poison fruit. Picking up the fruit, it said to the first head, "You selfish wretch! See, here's a poison fruit and I'm going to eat it!" "Don't do that, you fool!" shrieked the first head, "you'll kill us both!" But the second head would not listen. It consumed the poison and soon the two-headed bird was dead.

Selfishness and vengeance are two heads of the same animal, pride, which always brings suffering and destruction in its wake. When we feel or think we are better than someone else, we can also feel "entitled" to have more than the person who is "beneath" us, and can cause us to become selfish, like the first head of the *Bharunda*. And our selfishness we can cause great pain to others. The other head of pride (again when we feel or think we are superior to others), rears up when we feel slighted or offended by someone else, especially someone who we feel is "beneath" us. How dare someone like that embarrass me? In our pride we begin to seek vengeance and look for opportunities to "get back" at the offender, once again causing great pain to others, like the second head of the *Bharunda*.

If we contrast the vice of pride with the virtue of humility, we can easily see how much more at peace we will be, as well as how we will promote peace around us. Humility isn't just a nice virtue, it is a central theme in the life of Jesus, one that is at the core of our salvation and something that we are also called to follow. The great theologian and Doctor of the Church, St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us that humility begins with our relationship with God; the first act of humility consists in subjecting ourselves to God, and the next is to subject (in other words "to humble) ourselves to our neighbor for the love of God. This is nothing other than following the example and command of Jesus. As St. Paul tells us in the letter to the Philippians,

"Do nothing from selfishness or conceit, but in humility count others better than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." (Philippians 2:3-11).

Pride is the way to suffering and destruction while humility is the way to peace and salvation. May the Lord help us to see and understand the value of humility so that we follow not the example of the *Bharunda*, but that of our loving Lord.






In-person Religious Education classes have started. If your child is not registered for Religious Education, it is not too late. Please contact the office at 856-845-6826 to request registration forms.


