## Lingua Latium

For all of you linguists out there, you know the title of this week's article is "the Latin Language" in, of course, Latin. For all of the non-linguists out there, myself included, you probably guessed that's what it meant, anyway. I bring this up because starting the First Sunday of Advent, we will reintroduce singing some Latin parts of the Mass. I know that this has been done in the past at Holy Angels so there should be some familiarity with it.

This is not some sort of nostalgic, throwback idea. This is not Mass in Latin, nor is it the "Tridentine" Mass. This is Mass in English with the use of some Latin chants. Something that surprisingly, the Second Vatican Council called for. But one might ask, "Didn't we get rid of Latin in the Mass? Isn't that what Vatican II said?" Actually, it didn't. Unfortunately, in the years since Vatican II a lot of people keep telling us what the Council said, but not all that many people seemed to have read it thoroughly.

So, what exactly does the Second Vatican Council say about Latin in the Mass? In Vatican II's document on worship and liturgy entitled, *The Dogmatic Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy* (SC), it says this:

*"The treasury of sacred music is to be preserved and cultivated with great care" (SC 114).*

*"The Church recognizes Gregorian chant being specially suited to the Roman Liturgy. Therefore ... it should be given pride of place in liturgical services" (SC 116).*

This idea has also been reaffirmed in 2002 in the most recent update of the Church's liturgical laws and norms of the Mass called, *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM):

*"Gregorian chant holds pride of place because it is proper to the Roman Liturgy. Other types of music, in particular polyphony, are in no way excluded, provided that they correspond to the spirit of the liturgical action. Since faithful from different countries come together ever more frequently, it is fitting that they know how to sing together parts of the Ordinary of the Mass in Latin, especially the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. (GIRM 41)"*

Clearly, the Church encourages us to preserve our Latin heritage while at the same time we are to ensure the Mass is accessible as possible to people by the use of the vernacular, which in our case is English. Personally, I wouldn't want it any other way. All I really know is Mass in English and I think, if done with love and reverence, it is most beautiful. This initiative to include the use of Latin chants in the Mass is not some regressive, pre-Vatican II type of mentality, but rather it is an attempt to preserve some of our history and be faithful to what the Second Vatican Council has asked.

We will start slowly and gradually expand as we become familiar again with the chants. As in learning (or relearning) any new piece of music, there will be a bit of a rough period at first, but I am convinced we will get the hang of it in no time. I believe that this is completely faithful to the Church's intent and I hope that by working (and singing) together with open hearts we will ever more honor and glorify our loving Lord in our worship of Him at Mass.

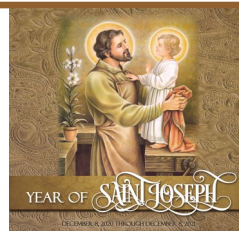
## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

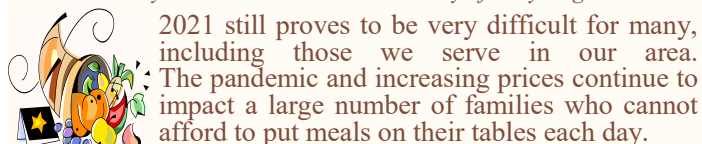
Catholic Charities, Diocese of Camden continues to work with newly-arrived families from Afghanistan, and we are expecting more families to be arriving soon.

Vespers is one of the “**Hours**,” the evening prayer of the Church, that are prayed daily. “The Liturgy of the Hours” are prayed by the ordained ministers, (bishop, priests and deacons) as well as many religious men and women, and the monastic orders. Lay persons in recent times have become more involved with praying “the Liturgy of the Hours”.

Most of the prayers in the Liturgy of the Hours come from the Psalms. Jesus prayed the very Psalms that we now recite. Mary most likely taught him the Psalms. Jesus quoted the psalms in his preaching and teaching. He recited them at key moments in his life to explain the meaning of his life experience. After the resurrection, the first Christians easily recognized the person of Jesus reflected in these Hebrew prayers.

You are invited to participate and pray these deeply moving reflections of humanity reaching out to God. Perhaps you can make this an Advent prayer to deepen your faith this year.

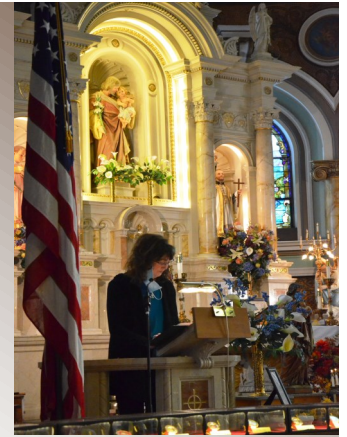
