CHRIST THE KING

Today is the last Sunday of the Church year. We literally begin a new year next Sunday, the first Sunday of Advent. As the readings of the day suggest, there is a focus on the end, when Christ the King will come and judge the world. It is not an accident that the Church presents readings such as these as we bring the year to a close. As Christians, we know that the end of this world is merely a transition for the new and eternal world under the kingship of Christ.

As we look to a new beginning in Advent, we look with anticipation to the coming of Christ. We prepare to celebrate not just his first coming in Bethlehem but also his second coming. At the same time, and perhaps even more important, we need to make sure we are also preparing ourselves for a new and more profound coming of Christ into our hearts. It is my deepest desire that all of us at Holy Angels open our hearts to the transforming power of the love of Christ the King.

It is only in Jesus Christ that the deepest yearning of our hearts can be fulfilled. It is only in Jesus Christ that salvation is found. It is only in Jesus Christ that a true peace and joy which can never be dimmed is revealed. If only we would allow ourselves to humbly submit to the kingship of Jesus, we would have more than we ever could if we were our own ruler. It can be so hard for us to see how submission to Christ and his love can be better than if we were our own rulers, but in the end acknowledging our place with respect to God our creator, is the only real path to the joys of his kingdom.

Perhaps a good theme for us this Advent might be to reflect upon the meaning of the coming of Christ into the world and how we are going to respond to his invitation to an ever deeper relationship with the King of Kings.




The first Thanksgiving is said to have been in 1621, when Governor Bradford of the Plymouth colony appointed a day for public praise and prayer after the first harvest, and the practice spread throughout the other New England colonies. The first national observance was when President Washington, at the request of Congress, recommended Thursday, 26 November, 1789, to the people of the United States "as a day of public thanksgiving and prayer to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many and single favours of Almighty God". This proclamation exhorted the people to "beseech Him to pardon our national and other transgressions, to promote the knowledge and practice of true religion and virtue, and to grant unto all mankind such a degree of temporal prosperity as He alone knows to be best".

As Catholics we recognize the vital importance of thanking God for the many blessings he gives to us. As part of your family celebration of Thanksgiving, I invite you to come to Mass at 9:00AM in St. Patrick's Church to give thanks to our loving Lord. You are also invited to bring bread or other food to the Mass where it will receive a special blessing and then be shared at the Thanksgiving table.



A Vesper Prayer Service will be held each Saturday afternoon during Advent prior to the 4PM Mass, beginning November 27th. The service begins at 3:25PM and should be about 15 minutes.

You are invited to come and pray the Evening Liturgy of the Hours, Vespers, with the Holy Angels community and the universal Church in preparation for Christmas.

If you come to the 4PM Mass, please plan to arrive a little bit earlier and experience this prayer of the Church.

Vespers is one of the "**Hours**," the evening prayer of the Church, that are prayed daily. "The Liturgy of the Hours" are prayed by the ordained ministers, (bishop, priests and deacons) as well as many religious men and women, and the monastic orders. Lay persons in recent times have become more involved with praying "the Liturgy of the Hours".

Most of the prayers in the Liturgy of the Hours come from the Psalms. Jesus prayed the very Psalms that we now recite. Mary most likely taught him the Psalms. Jesus quoted the psalms in his preaching and teaching. He recited them at key moments in his life to explain the meaning of his life experience. After the resurrection, the first Christians easily recognized the person of Jesus reflected in these Hebrew prayers.

You are invited to participate and pray these deeply moving reflections of humanity reaching out to God. Perhaps you can make this an Advent prayer to deepen your faith this year.


