## Advent 2021

*Let all mortal flesh keep silence, and with fear and trembling stand;  
Ponder nothing earthly minded, for with blessing in His hand,  
Christ our God to earth descendeth, our full homage to demand.  
(Liturgy of Saint James, 4<sup>th</sup> century)*



As we begin the holy season of Advent, I join with you in preparing for and awaiting the coming of our Lord. Given the upheaval we experienced during the past year, opening our hearts to Christ is even more important. I hope the different liturgical events you experience during our celebration of the Advent season here at Holy Angels will assist you in growing in faith and love of God. The more we open our hearts to the Lord, the more he can fill them with his grace and life.

The mood of Advent is expressed in the liturgical color violet. It depicts a feeling of quiet dignity, royalty, and repentance. Violet was the traditional color of a king's robe; the coming Christ is King of kings. Advent, like Lent, is also a time for solemn and sober thought about one's sins leading to repentance. The Advent season denotes a quiet time for watching, waiting, and praying for Christ to come again, both personally and universally.

Advent stresses not so much fulfillment as anticipation of fulfillment: the Lord is coming! Christians have great expectations of Christ's coming again. As a family looks forward to a son returning from war or a bride anticipates her wedding day, so a Christian looks forward with joy to Christ's coming. Yet, this is a different kind of joy - a joy of hope amid solemnity. It is the quiet joy of anticipation and not the joy of celebration of a past event. This type of joy is expressed in the Advent hymns: "O Come O Come Emmanuel...Rejoice, Rejoice, Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel."

Advent comes from the Latin word for an "arrival" or a "coming". Advent means that the Lord is coming. But He comes to us in different ways. First, Jesus came to us at a specific point in history at Bethlehem a little over 2000 years ago; and in the Church's great feast of Christmas he mystically comes again. Second, the Lord, Alpha and Omega, will come to judge the living and the dead in the Second Coming. Third, the Redeemer comes to us in grace. He speaks to us in our consciences; he comes to us in the Holy Eucharist and in the Word of God. He also arrives in the needy, the suffering, and the oppressed. We must be ready to receive and welcome Him when He comes, however He comes.

The theme of the Advent season is one of joyous expectancy as the Church, in vigilant preparation, waited and watched for the first signs of the coming of the Lord. The very name Advent, and the Masses of the four Sundays with their urgent plea to Christ to "hasten and delay not", remind us that we are awaiting His coming in grace and mercy not only at Christmas, but also in glory at the end of time.

May you have a blessed Advent and may God bless you,

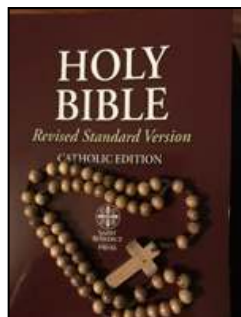
Prayer Intention books are in the vestibule of all of our worship sites.

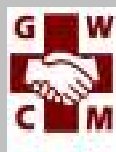
