The Nature of Peace

While it's difficult enough to endure the polarization and constant "war of words" that seems to be our current political environment, it is a whole other level when we see the tragic consequences of actual wars and conflicts going on in our world. The wars in the Holy Land and Ukraine might be most obvious, but there are many, many more armed conflicts going on in the world. And to see the human suffering and the loss of innocent lives - that occurs in every war - it is enough to break one's heart. As we get ready to welcome the arrival of the Prince of Peace at Christmas, perhaps it might be helpful to reflect on the meaning of peace and we as Catholics understand it in order to be better able to promote it. In the Second Vatican Council's document, *Gaudium et Spes* (The Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World) we are told about the meaning of peace:

Peace is not merely the absence of war; nor can it be reduced solely to the maintenance of a balance of power between enemies; nor is it brought about by dictatorship. Instead, it is rightly and appropriately called an enterprise of justice. Peace results from that order structured into human society by its divine Founder, and actualized by men as they thirst after ever greater justice. The common good of humanity finds its ultimate meaning in the eternal law. But since the concrete demands of this common good are constantly changing as time goes on, peace is never attained once and for all, but must be built up ceaselessly. Moreover, since the human will is unsteady and wounded by sin, the achievement of peace requires a constant mastering of passions and the vigilance of lawful authority.

But this is not enough. This peace on earth cannot be obtained unless personal well-being is safeguarded and men freely and trustingly share with one another the riches of their inner spirits and their talents. A firm determination to respect other men and peoples and their dignity, as well as the studied practice of brotherhood are absolutely necessary for the establishment of peace. Hence peace is likewise the fruit of love, which goes beyond what justice can provide.

That earthly peace which arises from love of neighbor symbolizes and results from the peace of Christ which radiates from God the Father. For by the cross the incarnate Son, the prince of peace reconciled all men with God. By thus restoring all men to the unity of one people and one body, He slew hatred in His own flesh; and, after being lifted on high by His resurrection, He poured forth the spirit of love into the hearts of men.

*For this reason, all Christians are urgently summoned to do in love what the truth requires, and to join with all true peacemakers in pleading for peace and bringing it about. (*Gaudium et Spes*, 78)*

Amidst whatever conflict we are witnessing or experiencing, how do we respond? Are we seeking peace? Are we seeking true justice and the common good for all? Pushing back against what is evil or wrong is fine as long as the goal is true justice and the common good for everyone. Seeking only to win and destroy our opponent is not just ineffective in bringing peace about, it is also against what it means to be a follower in Christ.

As we get ready for the beautiful celebration of the coming of our savior at Christmas, let us recommit ourselves to peace. First and foremost, let us pray for those places plagued by war, that authentic peace may come about by true justice, mutual cooperation and restraint. Then, secondly, may we ask the Lord for the grace we need to seek de-escalation and respond with peace and justice when faced with conflict in our own lives.




Agape/Love | Advent: Word Studies | The Bible Project

The word "love" is one of the sloppiest words in our language, as it primarily refers to a feeling that happens to a person. In the New Testament, "love" refers to a way of treating people that was defined by Jesus himself: seeking the well-being of others regardless of their response.



Mary of Nazareth


