“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God,
and the Word was God.” (Jn 1:1)

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.” (Jn 1:14)

The two Gospel verses above show forth the profound mystery of the incarnation. God, in the Word - the second person of the Blessed Trinity - takes on our human nature while retaining his own divine nature. In this wedding of the two natures in Jesus Christ, human nature is saved by divine nature. The celebration of Christmas is the celebration of the birth of our Salvation, the Word made Flesh.

And we can further reflect on how much Christ wants to bestow this infinite mercy of his upon each of us.

Nick Dudo, and Deacons Vincent Latini, Sam Spoto, Michael D'Ariano, and Dave Murnane, and our entire staff at Holy Angels, I want to wish all of you an abundant share of the Lord's love this Christmas. May Christ our Savoir fill your hearts with his love and bring you the peace and joy he wants you to enjoy.

Know that you and your families are in the Priests' intentions at all of the Christmas Masses. As we enter the New Year, may all of us be transformed more into the likeness of Christ so that after having received the love of Christ ourselves, we may share it with others.

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.


The True Meaning of Christmas | Lukas Storyteller


