## What about the future?

Did you know that there are people out there called “futurists”, people who seek to look at the present and attempt to predict the future? Sound a bit crazy? It’s not, really. There are professional futurists who get paid a lot of money by major corporations to do just that: predict the future. While some of them are probably pretty kooky, I would imagine there are also a number of successful ones, those that can look at the world as it is today and get a good gage at the future. After all, if a guy keeps predicting things that come out as he says, they maybe he isn’t so kooky after all.

One such successful professional futurist is David Zach. Mr. Zach thinks a lot about, and gets paid to talk about, the future. Interestingly enough, he maintains that without our most worthwhile traditions and principles, we are lost in the future without a compass. David Zach proposes, *“When looking at the world, you can divide much of it into Fads, Trends or Principles. A little mantra for this is that we should Play with Fads, Work with Trends, and Live by Principles...in modern times, we are too often Seduced by Fads, Ignorant of Trends, and Resistant to Principles.”* He also states, *“Not all principles are equally valued, just like not all change is forward. The great struggle of our age is to define what should change and what should stay the same.”*

Coming from a Christian perspective this makes perfect sense. One of the hallmarks of many of our recent popes is the battle against relativism. The “tyranny of relativism” is found precisely in the rejection of universal principles. Instead of acknowledging God’s Divine Law written into Creation (what we call Natural Law), the only law that seems to exist is that there is no law, what is right and good is what I happen to like today. There is nothing wrong except to try to tell me that there is a moral law that exists outside of me that I have to obey.

But as we experience time and time again, failure to obey God’s law will only result in our own suffering. It is not tyranny to follow our Creator, it is wisdom. Even a secular futurist like David Zach understands this even if he is not explicitly Christian. The promotion of relativism has made the immoral moral and we are suffering for it. Only the future will show us how much; and then it will be too late to undo what we have done without a long, painful process. This is why we must in our own lives first, but also publicly, follow and uphold God’s law. Pornography and the abuse towards women that it spawns, marital infidelity, artificial contraception, abortion, acceptance of homosexual activity and marriage, continued racism and prejudice, human trafficking, the “trans” culture, and the vast array of new addictions to go along with the older ones – these are all byproducts of a society that lives without principles, a society that has chosen not to follow God’s law. How much longer and how much further can we go, and what will be the result? I don’t think you have to be a futurist like David Zach to figure it out.

Now is the time for all of us to return to God and return to the obedience of God’s Law. For when we disobey God we not only bring suffering upon ourselves in this life, but we endanger our eternal salvation. It is not so much that God punishes us, as much if we choose to live without obeying God, he will allow it and then also allow us to experience the consequences of our actions. Which in this life usually entails great suffering, and in the next life, entails eternal separation from the God we chose to live apart from while on earth.

Yet, despite what we may have done or how bleak things may seem to be in our lives, the Lord is ever ready to pour out his mercy and forgiveness and healing grace upon anyone who wants to turn away from sin and the harm it causes and back to God and his love. The Lord loves us and wants nothing more to help us to be happy and at peace, that is why we can and should always be hopeful. For whenever we sincerely turn to the Lord we receive a future of joy and happiness; that is his promise to those who follow him.

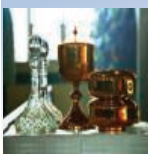

## JULY 2024 - HEALTHY VISION TIPS

Protecting our vision begins with keeping our vision healthy. Our eyes change throughout our lives, so it's important that we keep up with regular visits but also that we understand what vision changes are normal versus not normal.

Examples of normal changes with our eyes as we age are:

- » Become more sensitive to light
- » Need more lighting to see objects than we used to
- » Difficulty telling the difference between colors
- » Trouble seeing items close up

The risk for some eye conditions increases drastically as we age and those changes are not normal and require medical attention. These conditions are: **glaucoma, retinal disorders including diabetic retinopathy, cataracts, and age-related macular degeneration.**

One of the scariest things about these eye conditions is that many have no warning signs at all. It's important that you have a dilated eye exam so that the provider can visualize the back of the eye which is where some eye problems frequently occur.

If you have any of the symptoms listed below, it's important that you see an eye doctor right away:

- » Flashes of light
- » New or sudden eye pain
- » Double vision
- » Swelling or redness of the eye or on the lid of your eye
- » Sudden inability to see or everything is blurry

Vision is vital to everyone so it's important to educate yourself on how best to protect your eyes and take steps to keep them healthy.

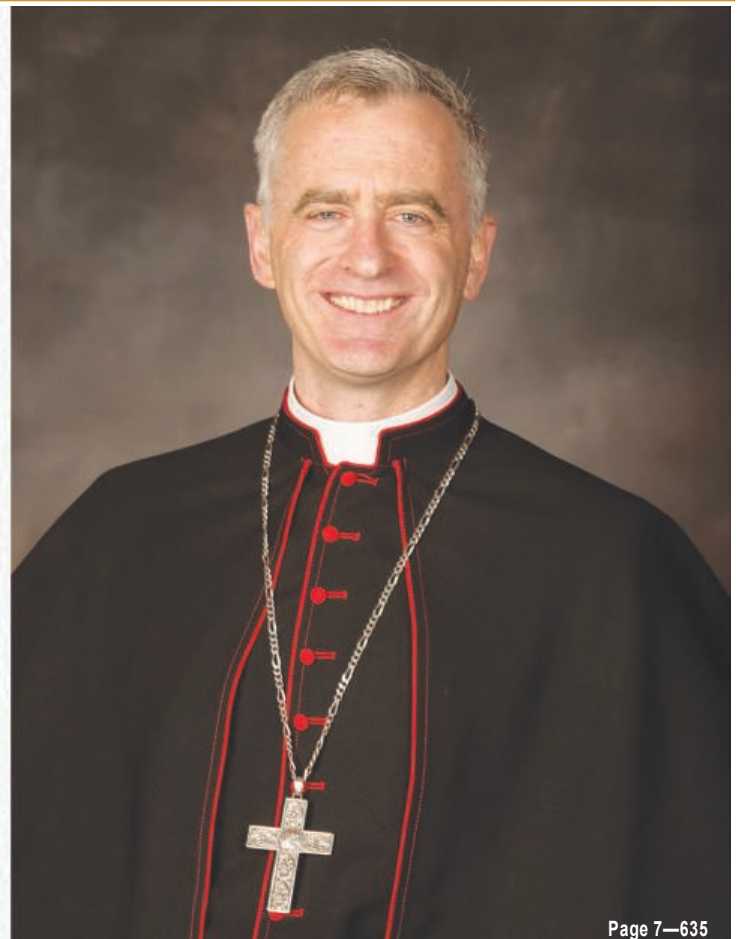

## ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

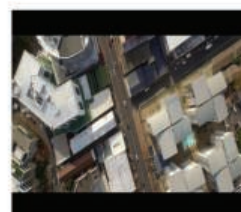
### The TRUTH About the Shroud of Turin w/Fr. Robert Spitzer | Chris Stefanick Show
