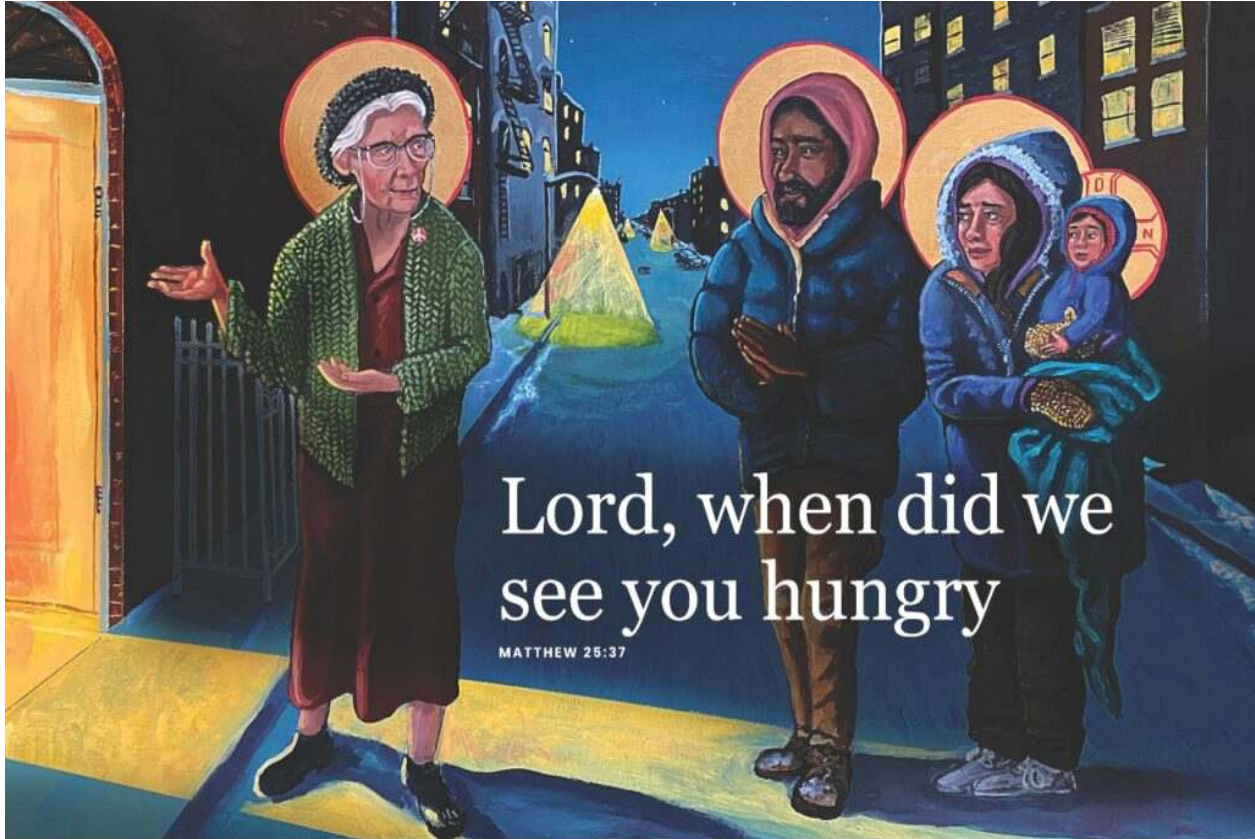

Back to School!

As we gear up for another academic year, before anything else, I want to once again wish the best and all God's blessings to all our Holy Angels Parish students and educators in whatever grammar school, high school, or university you are attending or working. I am praying for all of you that you may have a successful and good school year!

Also, I again want to highlight that from a Catholic perspective, the goal of education is to enable children to learn and develop - intellectually, physically, emotionally, and most of all spiritually - so that they can reach their full God-given human potential to contribute to the common good of society and to deepen their relationship with the Lord, leading to eternal salvation.

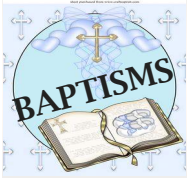
As you probably know, I was in Catholic education as a high school teacher at Paul VI High School for six years and I have learned how education plays a critical role in the development of young people. Having your children for about 30 hours a week, and usually even much more with sports and extracurricular activities, schools wield a tremendous influence on young people. That is why I strongly urge parents to show constant vigilance upon what is going on at the school(s) where their children are present, whether a Catholic school or not. Please talk to your children every day and find out what their teachers are saying in class. Be prepared to offer a response to them when you find that they are "learning" things that go against our faith, as well as affirming the good and true things that they are taught. This is especially important in our current cultural environment where there are many things in the state mandated curriculum for public schools that are contrary to the Gospel and harmful to our children.

Being intimately involved in the education of your children is not just the duty of parents, but also a great opportunity to bring the light of Christ and his love to them. Don't forget - the earlier the involvement starts and more constant it is, the less likely that it will seem intrusive to the children. Also don't forget to attend every possible event in which your children participate. They may not mention it, but you can be sure that your presence means very much to them.

Of course, the best thing any child can learn is how valuable a strong relationship with God is. That is why no matter what school children go to, it is essential they also attend the "school of faith" that has as its core faithful attendance to Mass on Sundays and Holidays. When we want our children to be good at math or any other subject, we tell them to study and practice the principles. It's no different with our faith. If we don't practice it, we will lose it, and it might not be there when we need it. So above all, show your children you love them and take them to Mass, pray with them, let them know the love Jesus has for them. Both your children and the Lord will be eternally grateful.

Please, for the love of your children, thoroughly check your children's phones and other electronics on a regular and random basis. It's not about distrust, but about protection and, most of all, love.

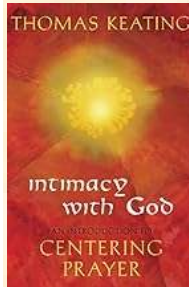

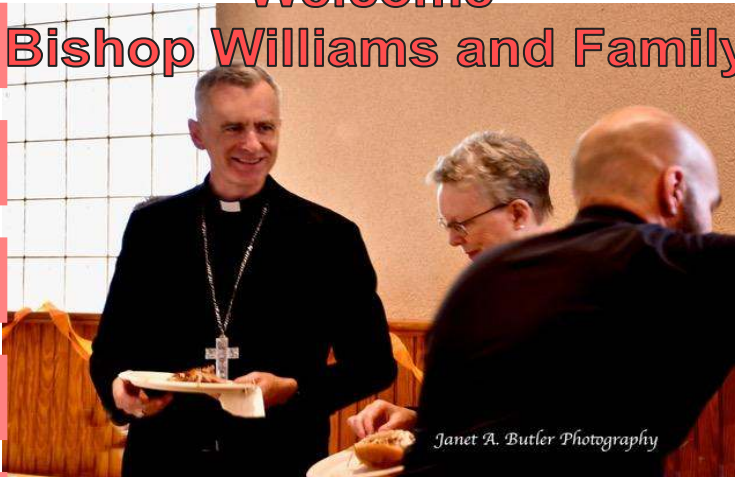

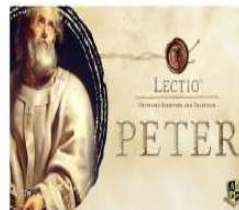
