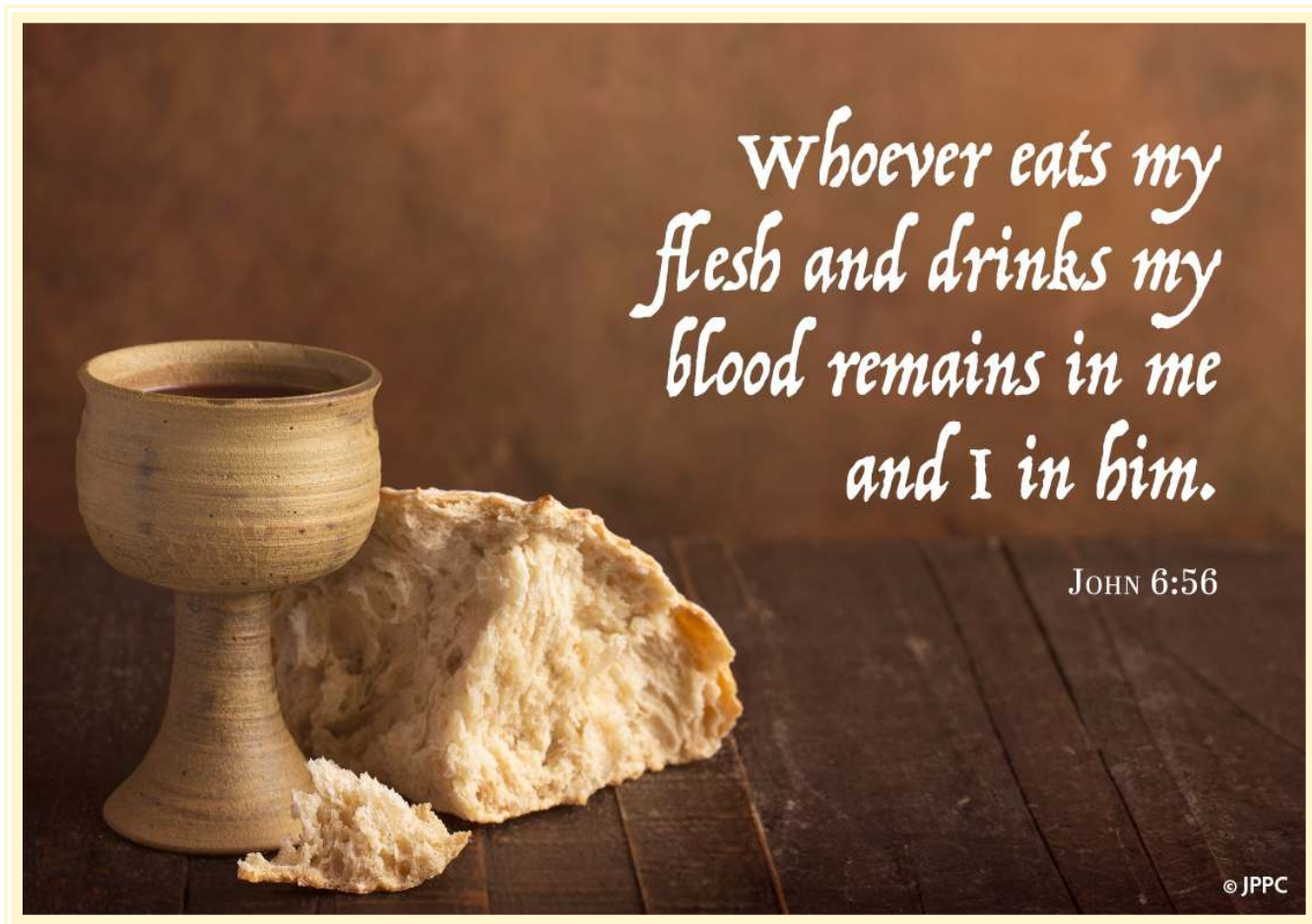

## Humanae Vitae – 56 years

On July 25, 1968 Pope St. Paul VI issued the landmark encyclical, *Humanae Vitae* (“Of Human Life”). In it, he reaffirmed the beautiful truth that a husband and wife are called to give themselves completely to each other. Marriage should reflect the love of God, which is faithful, generous, and life-giving. Through their vocation, spouses cooperate with God by being open to new human life. In the encyclical, Pope St. Paul VI offers us loving pastoral guidance on human life and love, telling us that our capacity to express love needs to reflect God’s own love for us – a love that is total, a love that is generous, a love that is life-giving and fruitful. While some may look upon *Humanae Vitae* as merely the prohibition of artificial contraception, in reality, it is first and foremost a positive and joy filled message of the truth about married love, human life and human sexuality.


For those unfamiliar with *Humanae Vitae*, its central feature is an affirmation of the Catholic teaching that the marital sexual intimacy between a husband and a wife should always be about **both** love and life, always be about **both** intimate union and openness to new life. Because they are so bound to the meaning of life and love, the unitive and procreative aspects cannot rightly ever be separated.

Paul VI has also been proven correct in his prophetic warnings about the consequences of ignoring this true meaning of married love: the breakdown of the family; young people growing up lacking love and family life; disrespect for women; sexuality becoming a commodity; and a redefinition of marriage. How accurately did St. Paul VI predict our current state after having ignored for the past fifty plus years God’s plan for human sexuality? We have never seen more confusion or pain in the heart of humanity regarding our bodies, our human nature and our human sexuality. We find ourselves struggling to understand how to see each other, how to interact with one another, and even how to see ourselves. One of the greatest tragedies of all is for a person to lose sight of who they are created to be by God, and what they are worth in the eyes of the Lord.

Pope St. Paul VI did understand the challenge this teaching presents: “It is to be anticipated that perhaps not everyone will easily accept this particular teaching.... In preserving intact the whole moral law of marriage, the Church is convinced that she is contributing to the creation of a truly human civilization. She urges man not to betray his personal responsibilities by putting all his faith in technical expedients. In this way she defends the dignity of husband and wife.”

Nonetheless *Humanae Vitae* should not be put aside or ignored. The Church has a body of teaching of good news about human dignity, good news about the dignity of human life, good news about the beauty, truth and love of human sexuality. Far from being ashamed of it or putting it in brackets for fear that it will not be accepted, it is something we need to proclaim and bear witness to. Our sexuality is one of the most profoundly personal aspects of our life. If we are willing to invite our Lord into this most personal part of our life, the Lord will without fail accompany us and help us to both see the beauty of the dignity that God has given it and the strength to live it out.
