## The primacy of Life

A couple of weeks ago, I wrote about Pope Francis' comments on our upcoming election. He spoke about how we are in a position of having to choose the "lesser of two evils". In essence, he was stating that there was no "good" candidate to vote for. By urging us to vote for the "lesser of two evils," Pope Francis encourages us to use our moral reasoning to choose the "less bad" one. While he did not state which one he thought was the less bad, I think there are some other comments that he made that can give us some direction.

On a very recent trip to Belgium, Pope Francis highlighted the pro-life witness of Belgium's King Baudouin, who temporarily abdicated his throne in 1990 so that he would not be forced to assent to a government bill legalizing abortion. Francis praised the late monarch's decision to "leave his place as king in order not to sign a murderous law." And, referencing proposed legislation that would further broaden access to abortion, he urged contemporary Belgians to reflect on their former king's courageous action at a time when "criminal laws are still being made."

It is important to note that voting is not only a civic duty, but a moral obligation. Pope St. John Paul II reminds us that, *"the value of democracy stands or falls with the values which it embodies and promotes. Of course, values such as the dignity of every human person, respect for inviolable and inalienable human rights, and the adoption of the 'common good' as the end and criterion regulating political life are certainly fundamental and not to be ignored."* We are morally obliged to participate in the political process as followers of Christ.

Ideally, there would be a candidate we could vote for that would espouse what we believe to be right and good and just, as revealed by God. But when no candidate does, we are in a quandary. That is where we are at the moment, and while there are ample, serious social justice issues both candidates get extremely wrong, we are provided a clear moral compass in The Catechism of the Catholic Church which emphasizes the sanctity of human life, *"Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception....From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person - among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life."*

In the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) document "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship," the importance of protecting human life is also highlighted, stating, *"The right to life is the first and most fundamental principle of human rights that leads Catholics to actively work for a world of greater respect for human life and greater commitment to justice and peace."* In addition, the USCCB document Living the Gospel of Life: A Challenge to American Catholics, presents a powerful analogy: *"If we understand the human person as the 'temple of the Holy Spirit' -- the living house of God -- then these latter issues [racism, poverty, hunger, employment, education, housing, and healthcare] fall logically into place as the crossbeams and walls of that house. All direct attacks on innocent human life, such as abortion and euthanasia, strike at the house's foundation. These directly and immediately violate the human person's most fundamental right -- the right to life. Neglect of these issues is the equivalent of building our house on sand. Such attacks cannot help but lull the social conscience in ways ultimately destructive of other human rights."* Obviously, no other inalienable human right can be exercised if one is not alive to exercise it.

As Bishop Daniel Thomas of Toledo stated beautifully in a recent letter to his diocese, *"The issue of abortion, the direct and intentional killing of an innocent baby in the womb, should weigh heavily on our consciences as we consider candidates in local and national politics and policies..... Voting as a Catholic means engaging with the political process in a way that reflects the love of Christ and the teachings of His Church. It is an opportunity to be the voice for the voiceless, to advocate for justice and peace, and to contribute to a society that upholds the dignity of every human person. Together, we approach this sacred duty with prayerful discernment, seeking the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we cast our votes for a more just society."*

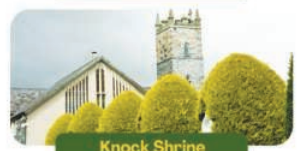

**Sunday, May 11th** - Depart Philadelphia to Dublin, Ireland.

**Monday, May 12th** - Arrive in Dublin and travel by coach to Galway. Lunch at the Johnstown Estate and Mass with the group. Dinner and overnight at the Salt Hill Hotel.

**Tuesday, May 13th** - Journey to the village of Knock. Celebrate Mass where the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John and the Lamb appear on the gable wall of the parish church. Then return to Galway for a relaxing cruise onboard the Corrib Princess on Lough Corrib. Dinner back at the Salt Hill hotel.

**Wednesday, May 14th** - Begin the day with Mass at Galway Cathedral then onto Caherconnell Fort & Sheepdog trials. Enjoy the great skills of the shepherds as they work the collies in a demonstration. After a stop at the quaint village of Adare, we arrive in Killarney for a 2-night stay and dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

**Thursday, May 15th** - Enjoy a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through Killarney National Park to Ross Castle. Then onto the Gap of Dunloe for some shopping at Moriarty's Gift Store. Dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

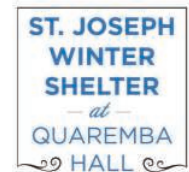

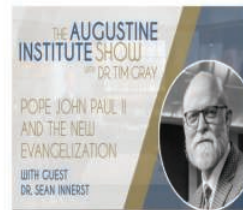

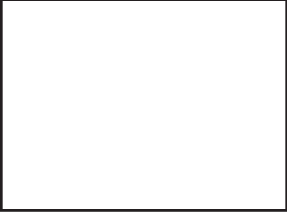
