The Demonization of America

Then they brought to him a demoniac who was blind and mute. He cured the mute person so that he could speak and see. All the crowd was astounded, and said, "Could this perhaps be the Son of David?" But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, "This man drives out demons only by the power of Beelzebul, the prince of demons." But he knew what they were thinking and said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself will be laid waste, and no town or house divided against itself will stand. And if Satan drives out Satan, he is divided against himself; how, then, will his kingdom stand?" - Mt 12:22-26.

In the Gospel passage above, our Lord Jesus expresses a fundamental point about any organization or group: internal division will cause it to collapse. While it is pretty obvious to everyone, it's surprising how often we get it wrong. I think what is left unsaid in the Gospel passage is that it is precisely the Devil that actively seeks to sow division among us. The Devil might be evil, but he is not dumb, quite the contrary; he is much smarter than we are. That's why we keep falling into his traps.

We have such a great country here in America, yet we continue to wound it by our ever-increasing hostility toward each other. While the attempted assassination of former President Trump might be an obvious, recent example, it is merely the "latest" example. Political rhetoric has always been pretty antagonistic. If you look back into even the early times of our country, people ran pretty nasty campaigns.

But what seems to have escalated to a level of ugliness (dare I say demonic?) is the outright, explicit, and absolute condemnation of the "person" of the political opponent. It's not enough to passionately disagree with a position or platform (which is totally acceptable and even laudable) but we seek to dehumanize the opponent. Thus, the less human our opponent, the less humanely we have to treat them. Eventually leading to our opponent not being worthy to even exist.

That is a kingdom divided against itself. It will fall as our Lord has said. No matter how much we disagree, or how much we think the other wrong, unless we see the other as a "someone" with whom we share a common humanity and equal human dignity and value, we will fall precisely into the evil hands of the Devil, who no doubt hates the principles upon which this country is founded and gleefully seeks to harm it.

We need to just stop. The Devil is our enemy, not each other. Our loving God has created us all in his wonderful image and likeness. The demonization of America does not have to be. Recognizing the God-given dignity and value of others, no matter who they are, is the first step to a unity that is stronger than the disunity and division of the evil one. We just need to want it and choose it. If we don't, it will only get worse.
