“The Lesser of two Evils”

Strange, and perhaps a bit shocking, is the above quote that Pope Francis made during a recent interview, called our upcoming presidential election in November. For those firmly (sometimes too much so) on one side or the other of the political spectrum, the Pope stating that both candidates are morally compromised because they both support evil positions might come as a disappointment. But I believe Pope Francis’ perspective has a great deal of merit.

Let’s have a bit of a refresher, first, on the moral principle of choosing the lesser of two evils. The principle is this: when faced with selecting from two immoral options, the least immoral one should be chosen. That is, in a case where there is no good (moral) choice, only evil ones, one would choose the lesser evil. This principle applies only where there is no good or moral choice. It is important to understand that if there is a choice between something morally good and something evil, one must choose the good.

I think the Pope is asking us to really look closely at the election and to see what issues are actually at stake and what issues the candidates hold. This is a quite different all too common approach today from the polemical, personal attacks that people seem to use all the more nowadays to justify one’s alliance with a particular candidate (or more common, to justify one’s dismissal of a candidate).

It seems almost a bit radical to suggest that people do research into the candidates’ positions and dig a bit below the surface from the political pundits that we find all over the news and social media. It is a shame that we have to do so much work today to figure out what the candidates actually believe, so filled with misinformation is just about every media outlet, including the candidates!

Nonetheless it can be done. And it is important we do so. Casting a vote is a moral action and therefore we need to make sure we are voting for a candidate that will do the most good in accord with the Gospel of our Lord. Or in this case, as Pope Francis acknowledged, the one who will do the least evil.

The choice really isn’t, as Pope Francis acknowledged, between a good candidate and a bad one, but, I guess one can say, between two not so good ones. Therefore, it’s not about whether you like a candidate, or dislike the other. It’s about what one truly believes they will do. So, who in your heart of hearts promotes the least moral harm to our society? Who embraces more serious evils than the other? Who advocates for less offenses to the Gospel than the other?

It’s not a fun choice for sure, but it’s one that we need to make. Read the platforms of the candidates and read them through the filter of our Catholic faith; find out what they support. Look at the history of the candidates in what they voted for or didn’t vote for. In doing so, I think there is one who is less “bad”, that is the lesser of two evils. Vote for that one, even if it is difficult.

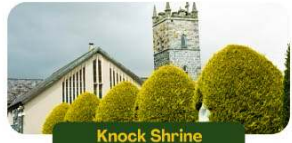

Sunday, May 11th - Depart Philadelphia to Dublin, Ireland.

Monday, May 12th - Arrive in Dublin and travel by coach to Galway. Lunch at the Johnstown Estate and Mass with the group. Dinner and overnight at the Salt Hill Hotel.

Tuesday, May 13th - Journey to the village of Knock. Celebrate Mass where the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John and the Lamb appear on the gable wall of the parish church. Then return to Galway for a relaxing cruise onboard the Corrib Princess on Lough Corrib. Dinner back at the Salt Hill hotel.

Wednesday, May 14th - Begin the day with Mass at Galway Cathedral then onto Caherconnell Fort & Sheepdog trials. Enjoy the great skills of the shepherds as they work the collies in a demonstration. After a stop at the quaint village of Adare, we arrive in Killarney for a 2-night stay and dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

Thursday, May 15th - Enjoy a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through Killarney National Park to Ross Castle. Then onto the Gap of Dunloe for some shopping at Moriarty's Gift Store. Dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

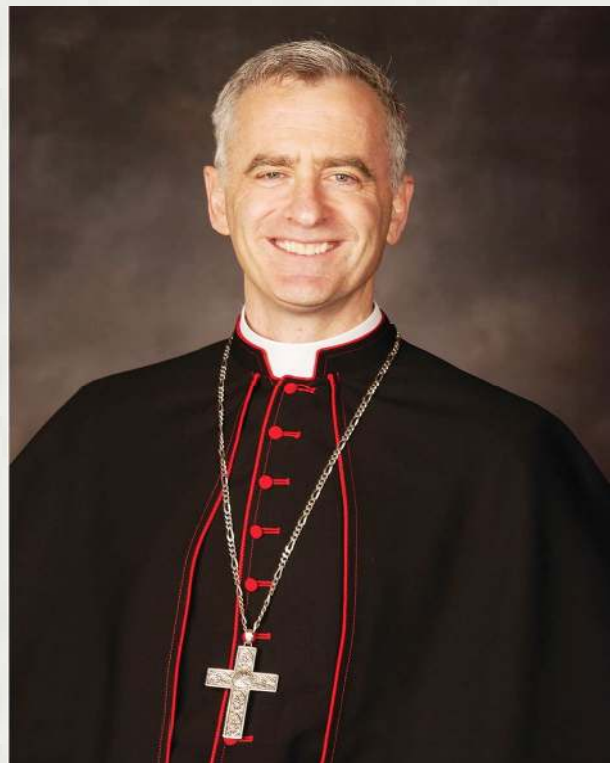

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

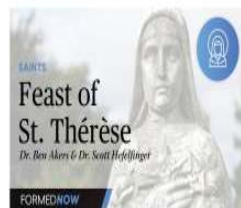
Who Are the Angels?
