Saint Joseph, Patron Saint of the Universal Church

This Tuesday is the Solemnity of Saint Joseph. Saint Joseph is the patron saint and protector of the Universal Church. Pope Pius IX, proclaimed him Patron of the Universal Church on December 8, 1870. In his decree Pius IX stated, “The Church, after the Blessed Virgin, his spouse, has always held him in great honor and showered him with praise, having recourse to him amid tribulations.”

Nineteen years later, Pope Leo XIII issued the only papal encyclical letter ever issued on Saint Joseph. In it, the Holy Father explained why Saint Joseph is Patron of the Universal Church, “The special motives for which Saint Joseph has been proclaimed Patron of the Church...are that Joseph was the spouse of Mary and that he was reputed the Father of Jesus Christ. From these sources have sprung his dignity, his holiness, his glory. In truth, the dignity of the Mother of God is so lofty that naught created can rank above it. But as Joseph has been united to the Blessed Virgin by the ties of marriage, it may not be doubted that he approached nearer than any to the eminent dignity by which the Mother of God surpasses so nobly all created natures...And Joseph shines among all mankind by the most august dignity, since by divine will, he was the guardian of the Son of God and reputed as His father among men. Hence it came about that the Word of God was humbly subject to Joseph, that He obeyed him, and that He rendered to him all those offices that children are bound to render to their parents. From this twofold dignity flowed the obligation which nature lays upon the head of families, so that Joseph became the guardian, the administrator, and the legal defender of the divine house whose chief he was. And during the whole course of his life he fulfilled those charges and those duties. And for such reasons the Blessed Patriarch (St. Joseph) looks upon the multitude of Christians who make up the Church as confided specially to his trust—this limitless family spread over the earth, over which, because he is the spouse of Mary and the Father of Jesus Christ he holds, as it were, a paternal authority. It is, then, natural and worthy that as the Blessed Joseph ministered to all the needs of the family at Nazareth and girt it about with his protection, he should now cover with the cloak of his heavenly patronage and defend the Church of Jesus Christ.”


Pope Saint John Paul II also discussed the importance of Saint Joseph’s patronage in our day “This patronage must be invoked as ever necessary for the Church, not only as a defense against all dangers, but also, and indeed primarily, as an impetus for her renewed commitment to evangelization in the world and to re-evangelization in those lands and nations where religion and the Christian life were formerly flourishing and...are now put to a hard test.”

As we honor Saint Joseph, let us be ever mindful of his particular connection to the Lord and so understand just how powerful his intercession can be. Trusting in this, we call upon him, to guide and protect our parish family as he did the Holy Family. St. Joseph, pray for us!






The Chrism Mass is a celebration of the priesthood and the occasion at which the bishop consecrates the sacred oils used in the sacramental life of the Church.





An Encounter with Mercy | Forgiven | Session 2

We are not defined by our mistakes. In Confession, Jesus invites us to encounter his mercy and be healed by his love. When he tells us "Go and sin no more," he also gives us the grace to do so.


