Holiness: Easy as one, two three

Some years back, the late Pope Benedict XVI offered a simple plan for holiness in one of his audiences. Being a saint really is not all that complicated, according to Benedict XVI, who gave a simple three-step recipe: Go to Mass on Sunday, begin and end the day in contact with God, and make decisions according to the Ten Commandments.

Citing Scripture and the Second Vatican Council, the Holy Father tried to present what is "the most essential" for reaching sanctity. He said: "What is the most essential? Essential is that no Sunday be left without an encounter with the Risen Christ in the Eucharist -- this is not a burden but light for the whole week. Never to begin or end a day without at least a brief contact with God. And, in the journey of our life, to follow 'road signs' that God has communicated to us in the Ten Commandments read with Christ, which is simply the definition of charity in specific situations.

Everyone is called to holiness, the Pope affirmed. "How can we journey on the path of holiness, how can we respond to this call? Can I do so with my own strength?" he asked. "The answer is clear: A holy life is not primarily the fruit of our own effort, of our actions, because it is God, the thrice Holy, who makes us saints, and the action of the Holy Spirit who encourages us from within; it is the life itself of the Risen Christ, which has been communicated to us and which transforms us."

Benedict proposed more questions: "Can we, with our limitations, our weakness, reach so high?" He recalled the line-up of saints presented by the Church in the liturgical year -- from every period of Church history, belonging to every age and state of life: "the concrete faces of all peoples, languages and nations. And they are very different among themselves."

And the late Pope pointed to other "saints," who are also "road signs": "the simple saints, that is, the good persons that I see in my life, who will never be canonized. They are ordinary people, to say it somehow, without a visible heroism, but in their everyday goodness I see the truth of the faith. This goodness, which they have matured in the faith of the Church, is for me a sure defense of Christianity and the sign of where the truth is."

It is the communion with saints, canonized or not, that enables cultivating a "firm hope of being able to imitate their way and share one day the same blessed life, eternal life," he reflected. Benedict XVI concluded with an invitation to be open to holiness.

He said: "I would like to invite you to open yourselves to the action of the Holy Spirit, who transforms our life, to be, we also, pieces of the great mosaic of holiness that God is creating in history, so that the Face of Christ will shine in the fullness of its brilliance. Let us not be afraid to look on high, to the height of God; let us not be afraid that God will ask too much of us, but let us be guided in all our daily actions by his Word, even if we feel that we are poor, inadequate, sinners: He will be the one to transform us according to his love."

Great words to us all!

Sunday, May 11th - Depart Philadelphia to Dublin, Ireland.

Monday, May 12th - Arrive in Dublin and travel by coach to Galway. Lunch at the Johnstown Estate and Mass with the group. Dinner and overnight at the Salt Hill Hotel.

Tuesday, May 13th - Journey to the village of Knock. Celebrate Mass where the 1879 apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John and the Lamb appear on the gable wall of the parish church. Then return to Galway for a relaxing cruise onboard the Corrib Princess on Lough Corrib. Dinner back at the Salt Hill hotel.

Wednesday, May 14th - Begin the day with Mass at Galway Cathedral then onto Caherconnell Fort & Sheepdog trials. Enjoy the great skills of the shepherds as they work the collies in a demonstration. After a stop at the quaint village of Adare, we arrive in Killarney for a 2-night stay and dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

Thursday, May 15th - Enjoy a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through Killarney National Park to Ross Castle. Then onto the Gap of Dunloe for some shopping at Moriarty's Gift Store. Dinner at the Great Southern Hotel.

Friday, May 16th - After Mass we visit Blarney Castle to kiss the Blarney Stone and shopping at the Blarney Woolen Mills. From there we travel to the Cobb Heritage Center, the last port of call to board the RMS Titanic. Dinner and overnight in Cork at the River Lee Hotel.

Saturday, May 17th - After Mass we will view the Rock of Cashel and travel onwards to the National Stud for a private tour where Ireland's best racehorses are bred. Onto Enfield Co. Meath for dinner and overnight at the Johnstown House Estate.

Sunday, May 18th - After Mass we will sightsee on the famous green Hop On Hop Off tour: bus, visiting the Guinness Store house. The EPIC Museum in Dublin is our final stop. Then onto the Johnstown House Estate for a farewell dinner and overnight.

Monday, May 19th - We depart Dublin for our return trip to Philadelphia.

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.



OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

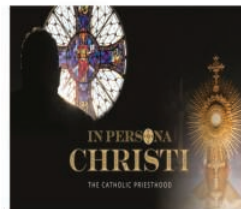

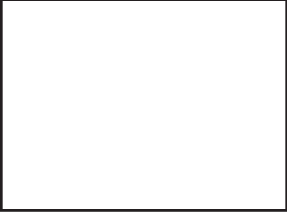
