## **Divine Mercy Sunday**

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina, who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread.

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

- A** - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- B** - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.
- C** - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

As we celebrate the feast of Divine Mercy today, may we trust in and open our hearts to the Lord's infinite mercy and love that he wants to share with us!

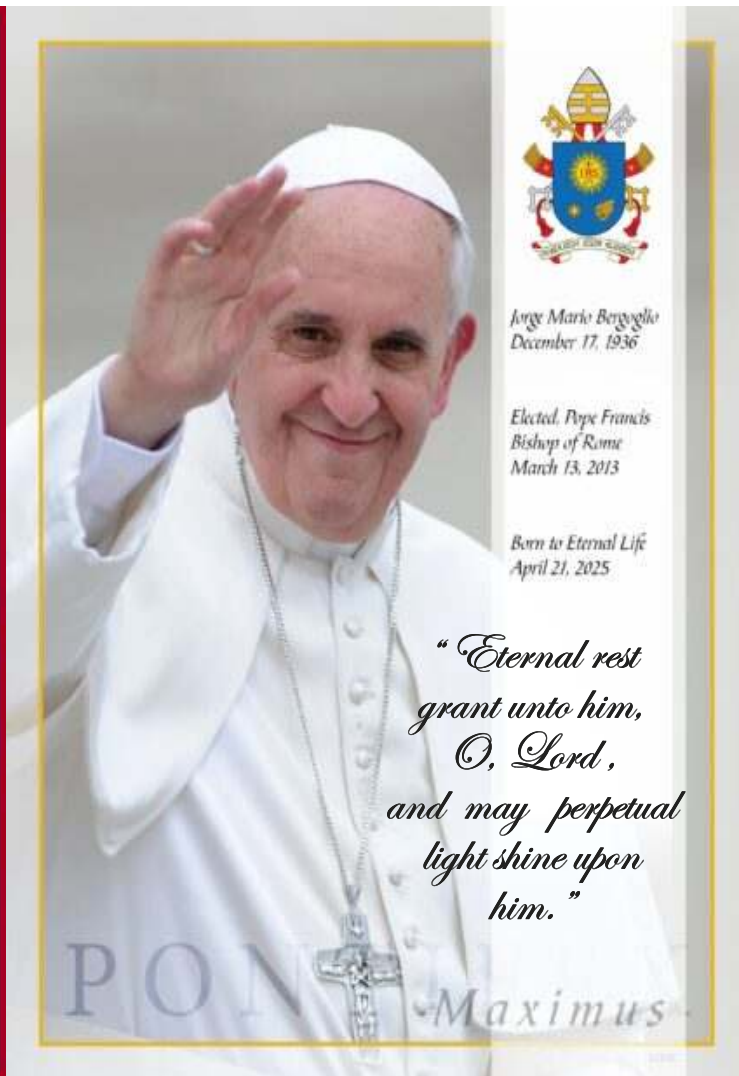

## Divine Mercy Sunday—April 27, 2025

### The History

Jesus began appearing to St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, in 1931. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on her published diary which describes the revelations she received from Jesus. St. Faustina died in 1938 at 33 years old and was canonized by St. John Paul II in 2000.

### The Promise

Our Lord Jesus said, “The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.” - Saint Faustina, Diary, 699.

### The Image

“I desire that this image be venerated throughout the world. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I promise victory over its enemies, already here on earth, and especially at the hour of death. I myself will defend it as My own glory.” The Divine Mercy image hangs in our St. Lucy Chapel throughout the year and will be displayed on Divine Mercy Sunday.

### To Observe Divine Mercy Sunday

Sincerely repent of all your sins. Place your complete trust in Jesus. Go to Confession (This can be before Divine Mercy Sunday during Lent or the Easter Octave.) Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. Ask for the extraordinary grace of Divine Mercy Sunday after receiving Communion. Venerate the image, with a prayer before it such as, “Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!” Be merciful to others through your actions, words and prayers.

### How to Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles’ Creed.
2. Then, on the Our Father beads, say the following: “Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the world.”
3. On the 10 Hail Mary beads say the following: “For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.” (Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades).
4. Conclude with (three times): “Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.”

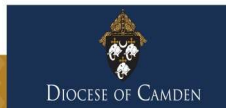

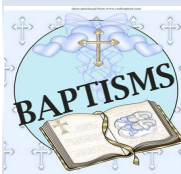
