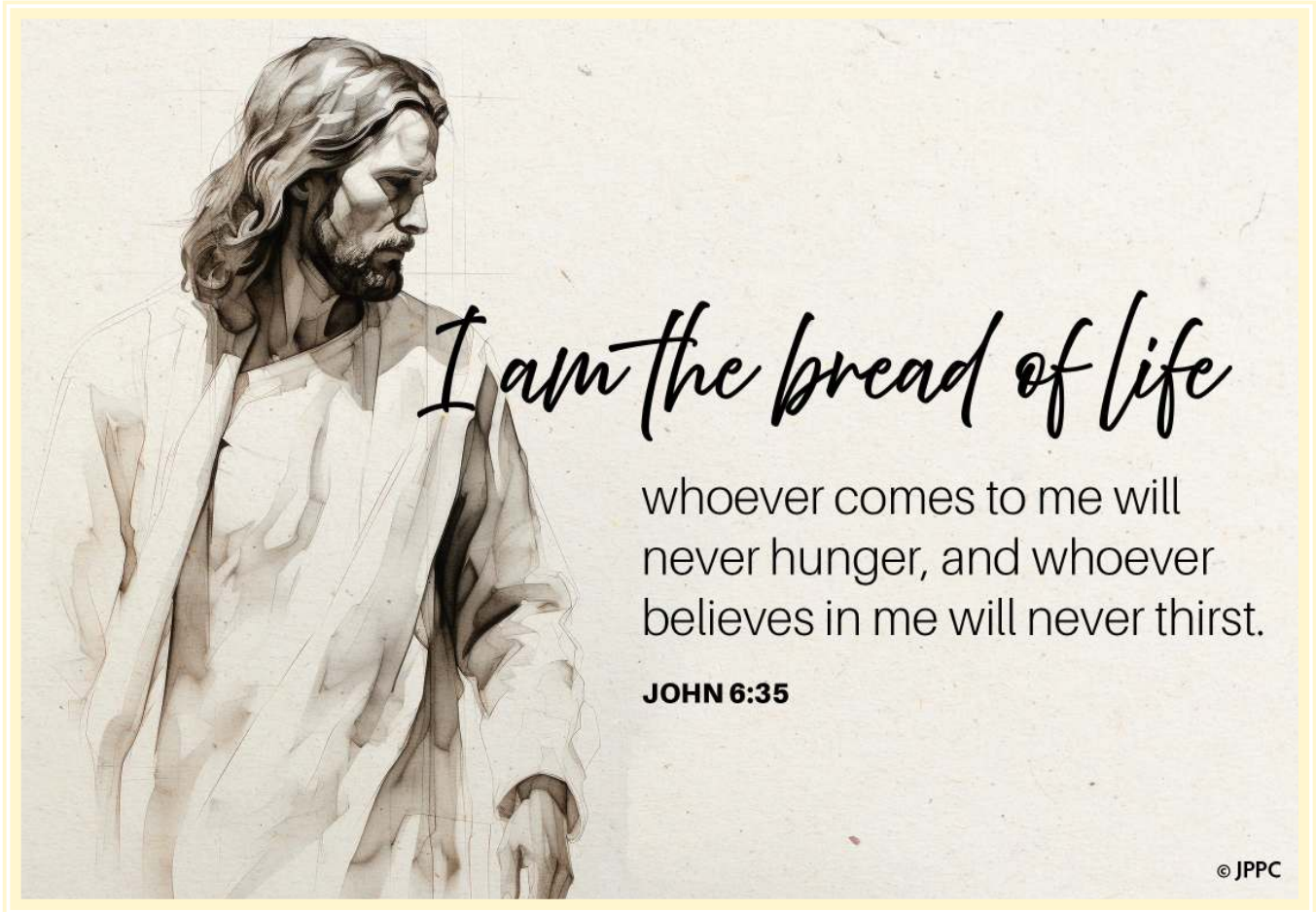

## Knowledge and Wisdom

I saw a video clip the other day that was both humorous and insightful. It was the response of a rugby player to a question at a new conference. I don't know what the question was, but his answer was terrific. He said, "Knowledge is knowing a tomato is a fruit. Wisdom is not to putting it in a fruit salad." Given that the "conventional wisdom" of rugby players as ruffians that are neither smart nor wise added a bit of irony to a very perceptive understanding of reality. And I think it is a good jumping off point for some reflection.

Firstly, it is completely accurate to differentiate between knowledge and wisdom. Knowledge is the acquiring of facts, information, and skills of a particular subject through experience or education. Maybe we can call it the "stuff" of a situation. Wisdom, on the other hand, is the soundness of an action or decision with regard to the application of knowledge. In other words, Wisdom is using the "stuff" we know properly and appropriately.

Even though they are distinct from each other, I think we can see that there is a very close connection between knowledge and wisdom. One really can't function well without possessing both. Although we all have differing natural abilities and talents that God gave us, it is important to see that in order for us to reach our full God given potential, we need to constantly seek out acquiring knowledge and to develop our wisdom.


A couple of things stand out here to me. First of all, for knowledge to be knowledge it has to be true. You can't make a good decision with faulty knowledge. You can be the smartest engineer in the world, but if you use faulty steel to build a bridge it will fail. Secondly, merely having the true facts is not enough. One needs to properly use knowledge one has for the decision to be wise and just. You can have all of the facts about a car that you are looking to buy, but if you decide to buy it just because you like the color even though you know it has many mechanical problems, you have made an unwise decision that will cost you.

Both of these - acquiring accurate knowledge and properly using it can be challenging in today's world. With what seems to be a great willingness to both mislead by distorting the facts and to misuse the facts at hand, we are in a pretty significant bind.

That's why it is all the more important for us to do two things. Firstly, to take the time necessary to obtain the facts crucial to the situation (and scrutinize them appropriately to make sure they are correct). And secondly, to take the time necessary to think about the facts and rationally and reasonably decide on a course of action. All too often today we do neither. We accept as facts the things we like just because they are what we want to hear. And then use them as the justification to do or say the things we want to do or say. Indeed, this way is easier and doesn't require us to ever change our perspective about anything. And sadly, it can also result in us hardening our hearts and further dividing us from each other.

Certainly, this is not the way of the Lord. When Jesus said, "the truth will set you free," and also, "I am the way, the truth, and the life," he was intending to challenge us to make sure we sincerely seek the truth and to follow it when we find it; regardless of what we would like to believe or like to do. Self-discipline is not just about not having too much dessert or spending too much time on our phones, it is also about the honest effort we give to learning the authentic truth of a situation and to respond to it justly and fairly and reasonably. Refusing to in both cases, to allow our "knowledge" and "wisdom" to be controlled by our emotions and passions. By doing this, we are opening ourselves up to Truth himself, Christ...the standard of Holy Truth and Holy Wisdom.

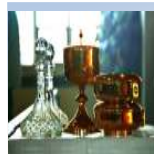

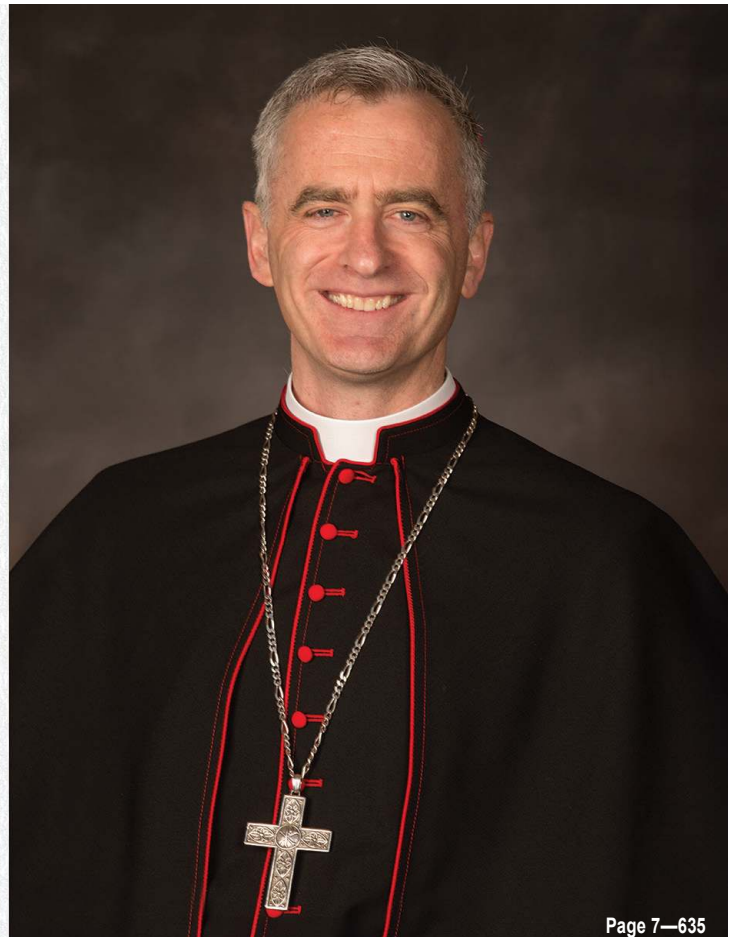

## ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

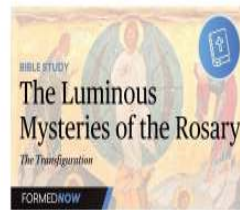
