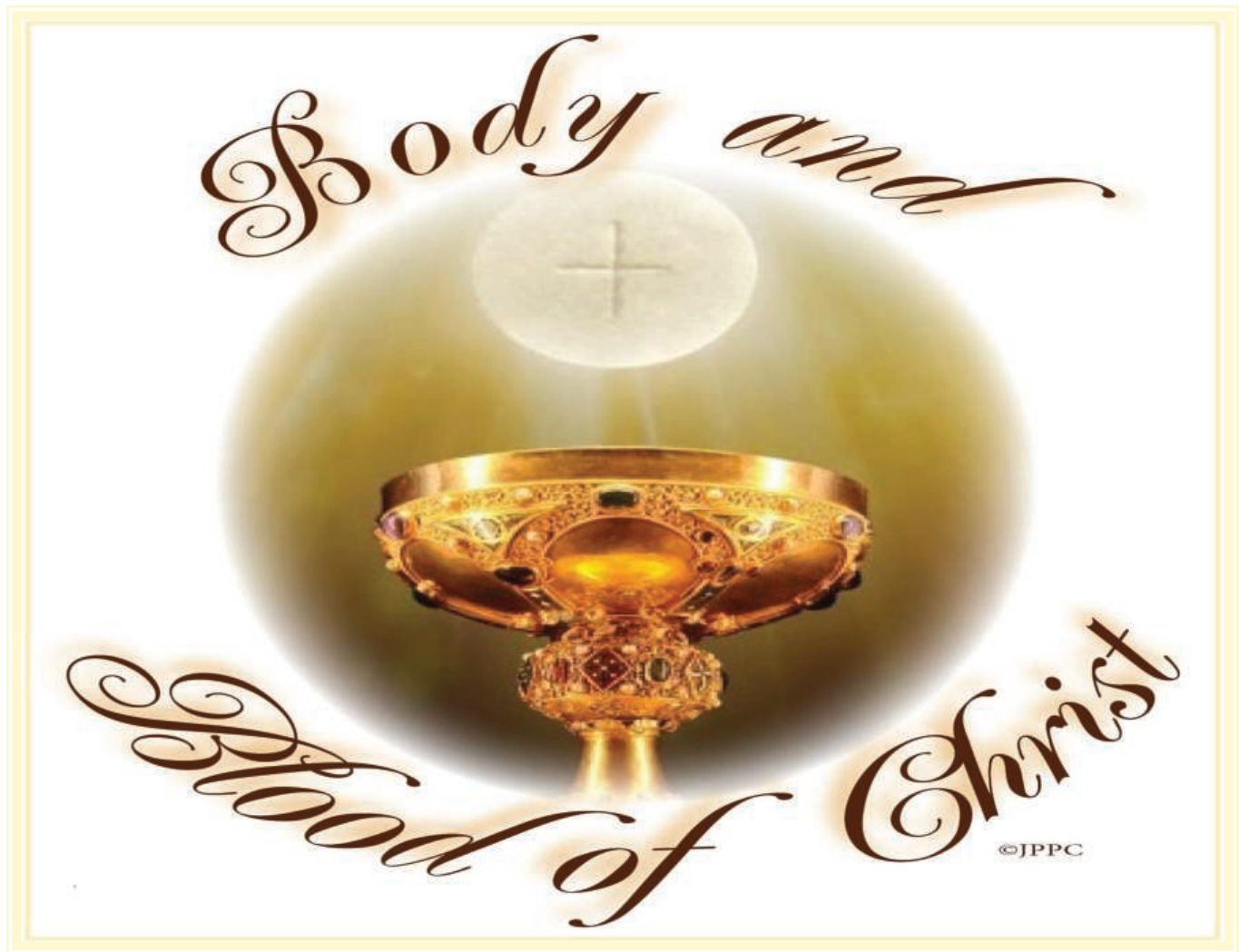

Thoughts on Communion

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, I recall the recent survey that studied the beliefs and practices among a sample of people who identify themselves as Catholics. The survey was completed by the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) at Georgetown University and commissioned by the Department of Communication of the U.S. Conference of Bishops. Without recounting the whole survey, I would like to focus on just one aspect, the Holy Eucharist. In the survey, 57 percent of self identified Catholics say that their belief in the Holy Eucharist is best expressed by the statement “Jesus Christ is really present in the bread and wine of the Eucharist. 43 percent say their belief is best expressed by the statement “Bread and wine are symbols of Jesus, but Jesus is not really present.” In the 2001 CARA survey, the numbers were 63% and 37% respectively.

This is greatly troubling. From the earliest moment of the Church and Christianity, the belief in the true, actual presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist has been central to our faith and our identity. Fortunately, for those who attend Mass at least once a week, the belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is 91percent, although why it isn't 99 or 100 percent for those who regularly attend Mass, I don't know. The fact that belief in a central element of our faith is in serious decline (a 9.5 percent decrease from 2001 to 2008) is very serious. No doubt it has to do with an overall decline in religious practice, which implies that part of the solution would be to increase the number of those who practice their faith. One of the hallmarks of the late Pope Saint John Paul II, as well as Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, and our current Holy Father, Pope Francis, was and is evangelization, and even more so, re-evangelization of those lands where the faith is weakening. All of these Popes understand the significance of the connection between worshipping and believing.

Since the vast majority who actually pick up a church bulletin and perhaps even the minority who may read my boring columns are those who do attend Mass, what do these numbers have to do with you? Chances are you already believe that Jesus is present in the Holy Eucharist. Chances are that you believe that Jesus himself is fully present -body, blood, soul, and divinity- in every particle of the Sacred Host and in every drop of the Precious Blood.

Two thoughts then come to my mind.

First: Since this is our faith and this is what we believe, then we need to make absolutely certain that we are completely prepared spiritually to receive the Lord. And when we do, we do so reverently, showing the Jesus we do believe in him and his presence. That means we must be free from serious sin, have fasted from food and drink for one hour, and earnestly desire the Lord to unite himself with us. The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith as the Second Vatican Council taught us. This makes perfect sense since in reality the Holy Eucharist is truly Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Therefore, we have to make absolutely sure we are properly prepared to meet him in Holy Communion.

Second: Having worthily and reverently received the Lord, now united with our bodies and souls, we must be willing then to bring the Lord now in our hearts to others so that, inspired by our faith and love, they may too want what we have....the Lord dwelling within them. This is the foundation of evangelization and it is the foundation of our faith. Let us never take for granted the gift we have in this great mystery of Jesus Christ uniting his very self to us in the Most Holy Eucharist.

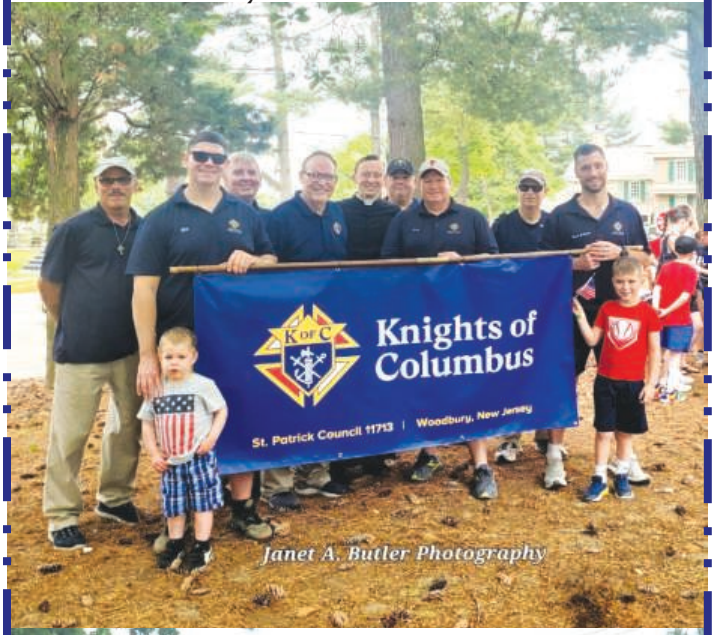

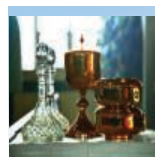

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

OICIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
