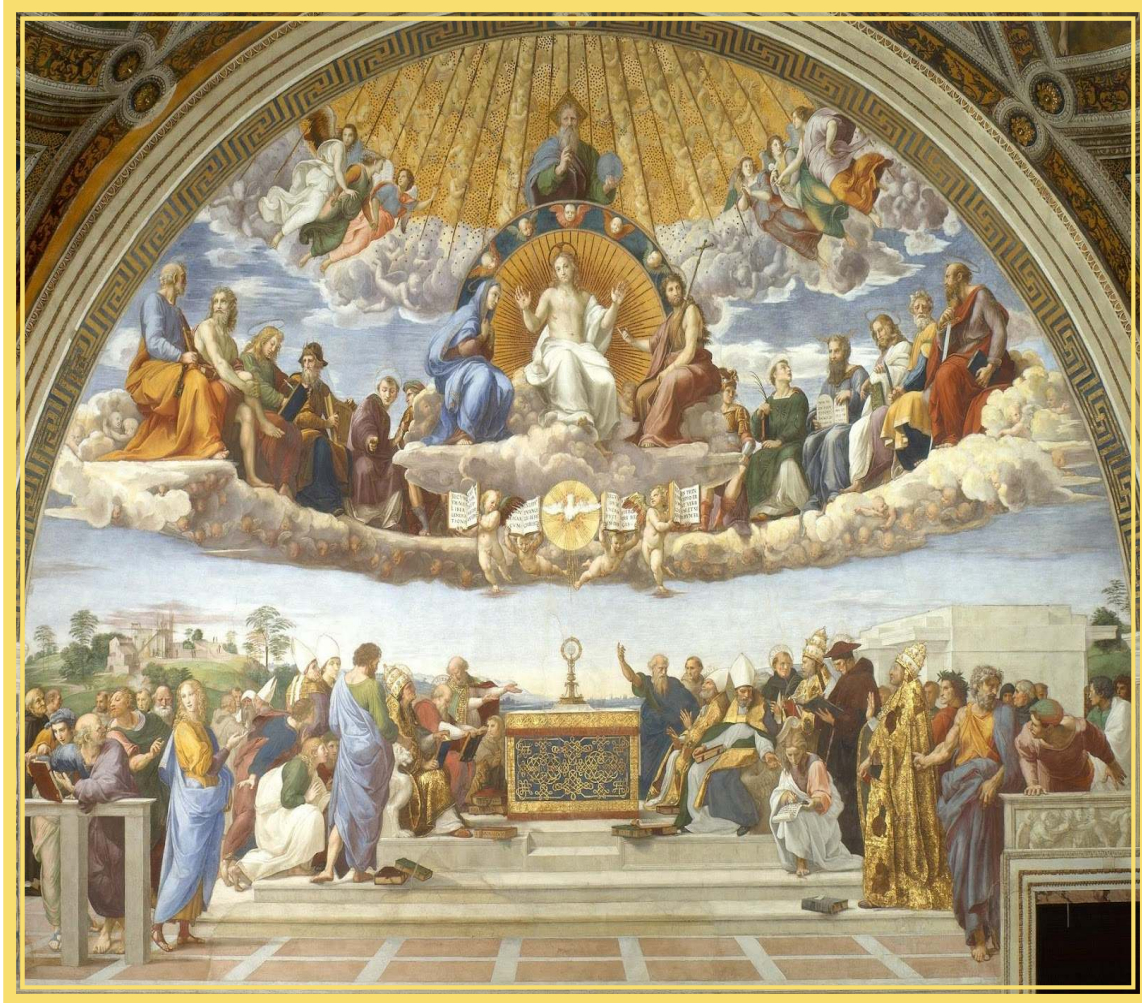

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Virtue of Temperance

The last of the four Cardinal Virtues is Temperance. Recalling that one way of describing a virtue is the mean between the two extremes of excess and deficit, Temperance can be one of the easiest of the virtues to understand. The Catechism defines the virtue of Temperance as “the moral virtue that moderates the attraction of pleasure and provides balance in the use of created goods. It ensures the will’s mastery over instincts and keeps desires within the limits of what is honorable.” (CCC 1809) Enjoying a couple of handfuls of Doritos is being temperate; eating the whole bag is not. God has given us certain instinctive desires (e.g. food, drink, comfort, sex, etc.) that are both necessary and good. The virtue of Temperance helps us to make sure these healthy desires do not get out of hand and lead us away from God.

Temperance is more than just not letting desires get out of control. Sometimes the use of the term “moderation” in the context of Temperance can seem somewhat negative. Temperance, like many virtues, can end up always being seen as restrictive. But that is not so. A temperate person is not a person, for example, who suppresses all inclination to anger. On the contrary, a temperate person does get angry when the situation warrants it, but gets angry to the degree that is called for in the situation. Intemperance would occur if a person never gets angry, as well more familiar case of getting too angry. Similarly, it is in accord with God’s will, healthy and temperate to desire sexual union with one’s spouse. On the other hand, intemperance with regard to sexual desire is found both in the less common example of the denial of one’s sexual desire as well as the more common fulfillment of one’s sexual desire outside of marriage whether through adultery, fornication, pornography, etc.

Other desires also fall under the banner of Temperance as well. For instance, the desire “to know” is a powerful instinct within us. This is a good desire; we should want to know things. Yet we can go both too far and not enough. Being apathetic and not caring to know what is going on around us is intemperance. Also, is desiring to know too much, more commonly known as being “nosey” and getting into everyone’s “business” when one has neither the right nor the need to do so. Genuine, temperate concern may cause us to wonder at unusual activity at a neighbor’s house, however “staking out” our neighbor to see exactly what’s going on is excessively inquisitive and intemperate.

In this limited space it would not be possible to detail the temperate exercise of each of our instincts and desires. But with a bit of reflection, we should be able to recognize the desires in our lives and seek, in cooperation with God’s grace, to enjoy them according to his will. For it is in the temperate enjoyment of the earthly goods that the Lord has provided us, that we are oriented towards what is our greatest good, God.
