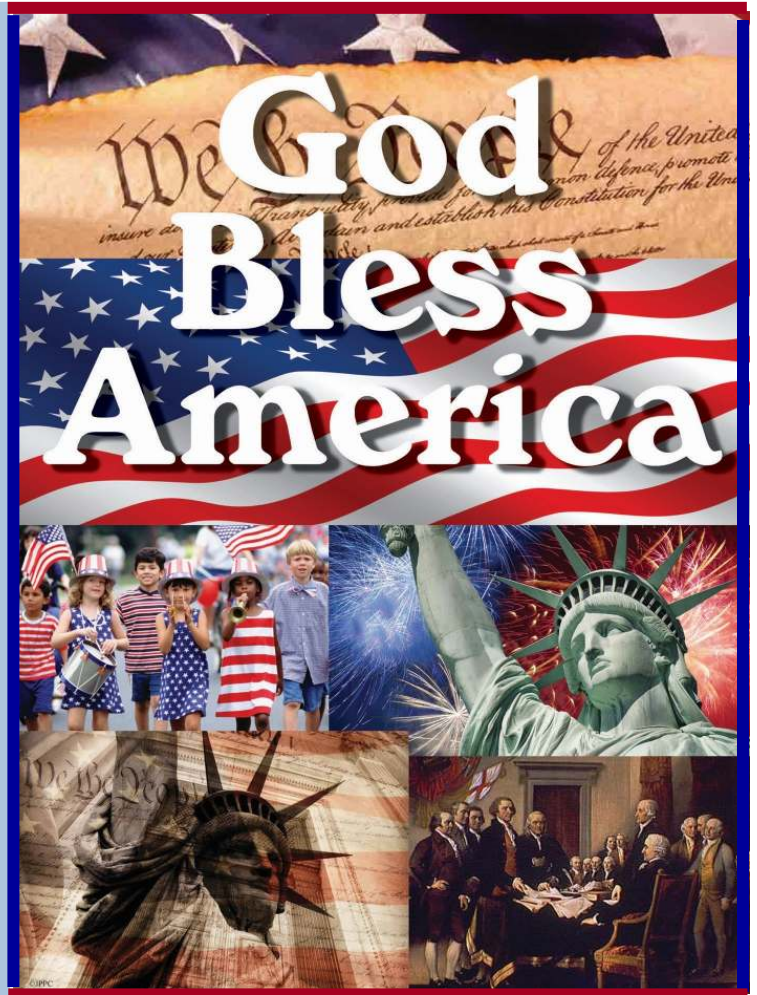
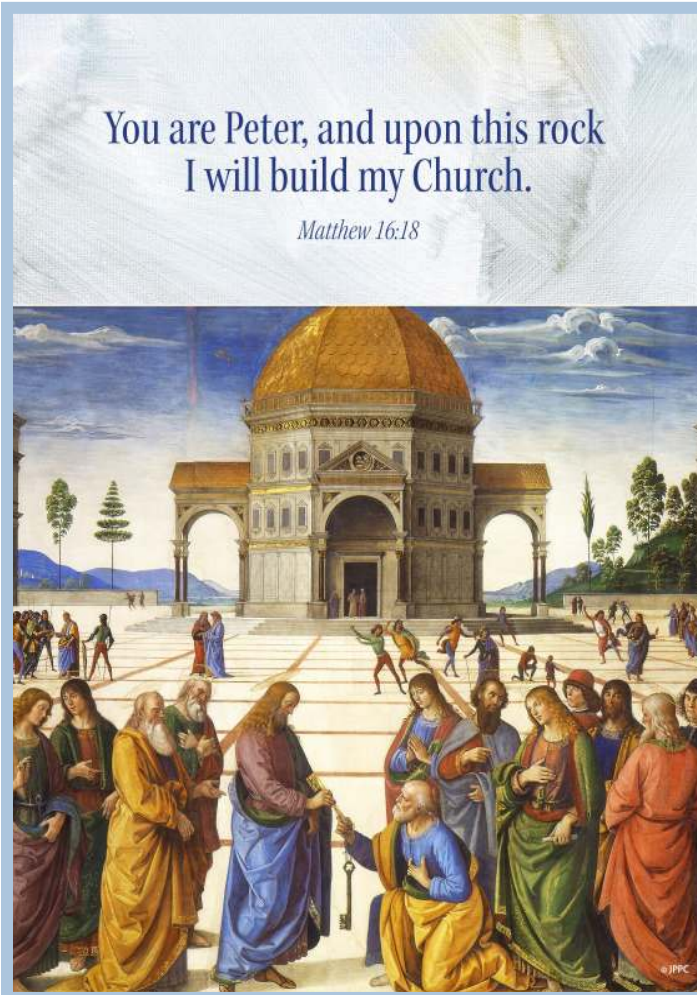

*Ave atque Vale!
Hail and Farewell!*

The life of a priest is to be modeled on the imitation of the High Priest, Jesus Christ. We are ordained to serve the people of God according to the direction of the chief shepherd of the diocese, the Bishop. If we priests are to take this role seriously, we must not just say the words of Jesus, but mean them as well... "I came to serve and not to be served" and "Not my will but Thy will be done." Thus, we go where we are sent by our Bishop. Without a doubt, on a personal level, moving on from a place where we have made deep bonds of friendship and affection is quite difficult. At the same time, we know that our humble obedience (that we promised God at our ordination) is always the will of God for us. And doing the will of God is what we are to do, and is ALWAYS the right thing, even if it is not always what we "want".

With this in mind, we bid a sad but trust-filled farewell to both Father Gallagher and Father Dudo. We knew this day would come but its arrival still hurts a bit. The three of us remarked over dinner many, many times how blessed we were to be together as long as we were. I will miss them as I am sure you will. They have faithfully served you and the Lord here at Holy Angels and I know that due to their beautiful and holy expression of priesthood, they will be greatly missed by all. Fr. Dudo is becoming Pastor at the Catholic Community of the Holy Spirit in Mullica Hill. Fr. Gallagher will be part time parochial vicar at St. Mary's in Gloucester and continue as part time director of Catholic identity at Gloucester Catholic. As they move on to their next assignments, please, let us keep them in our prayers and always be grateful to the Lord who gave these great priests to us.

We are also very fortunate to welcome Father Joshua Nevitt! He has been assigned to us by Bishop Williams to be part time parochial vicar here at Holy Angels. Fr. Nevitt will remain as one of the vocation directors of the diocese and also continue to assist the Bishop at large diocesan ceremonies. Fr. Nevitt will reside just up the road at the Bishop's residence. Please make sure you give him a big Holy Angels welcome and include him in our prayers.

Clearly, we will have less priestly assistance as we have had, but we will be OK. I hope to keep the same Mass schedule, we will see how that goes. The inability to fully replace the departure of Father Gallagher and Father Dudo is a sign that even at Holy Angels we are beginning to feel the effects of the priest shortage crisis. Please pray for, work for, and encourage priestly vocations!

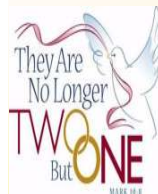

CANONICAL CORONATION ST. MARY OF MOUNT CARMEL PARISH HAMMONTON, NJ

To commemorate the 150th Anniversary, a **Canonical Coronation** has been granted by **Papal decree**, a rare and profound honor bestowed by the authority of **Pope Frances**. He has recognized the longstanding tradition of the Mt. Carmel Procession of the Mount Carmel Society! The coronation will be celebrated by **Bishop Joseph A. Williams** during the **2:00PM Our Lady of Mount Carmel Society Mass on the Feast Day, July 16th**, as he crowns the **Baby Jesus in honor of Our Lady**.

A canonical coronation is a formal act by the Pope, expressed through papal bull (public decree), to crown a venerated image of Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary, or St. Joseph. This act acknowledges the images local and universal significance within the Catholic Church. This is a rare honor for the church and our diocese. In the United States, only four Marian images have received this honor.

1. **Our Lady of Prompt Succor**
Crowned on November 10, 1895 in New Orleans, LA
2. **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**
Crowned on July 10, 1904 in New York City, NY
3. **Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception**
Crowned on August 22, 2013 in Lake Charles, LA
4. **Our Lady of La Leche**
Crowned on October 10, 2021 at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine in Florida

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

OCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
