The Prophetic Witness of Pope Benedict XVI

It's a bit hard to overestimate how prophetic these words are. They are written by Joseph Ratzinger (the future Pope Benedict XVI) in 1970 when he was still a young theologian.

"The church will become small and will have to start afresh more or less from the beginning.

She will no longer be able to inhabit many of the edifices she built in prosperity. As the number of her adherents diminishes . . . she will lose many of her social privileges. . . As a small society, [the Church] will make much bigger demands on the initiative of her individual members....

It will be hard-going for the Church, for the process of crystallization and clarification will cost her much valuable energy. It will make her poor and cause her to become the Church of the meek . . . The process will be long and wearisome as was the road from the false progressivism on the eve of the French Revolution — when a bishop might be thought smart if he made fun of dogmas and even insinuated that the existence of God was by no means certain . . . But when the trial of this sifting is past, a great power will flow from a more spiritualized and simplified Church. Men in a totally planned world will find themselves unspeakably lonely. If they have completely lost sight of God, they will feel the whole horror of their poverty. Then they will discover the little flock of believers as something wholly new. They will discover it as a hope that is meant for them, an answer for which they have always been searching in secret.

And so it seems certain to me that the Church is facing very hard times. The real crisis has scarcely begun. We will have to count on terrific upheavals. But I am equally certain about what will remain at the end: not the Church of the political cult, which is dead already, but the Church of faith. She may well no longer be the dominant social power to the extent that she was until recently; but she will enjoy a fresh blossoming and be seen as man's home, where he will find life and hope beyond death."

- Joseph Ratzinger (Benedict XVI), from his book Faith and the Future

We are already seeing Christians and especially Catholic Christians becoming increasingly marginalized in society and culture. How far will it go is unsure. But what is sure is what the late Benedict XVI states above: there will be more and more of a social and cultural "cost" to being faithful to the Jesus Christ and his Church; it will no longer be easy or popular to be a faithful Catholic. We will all have to answer the question in our hearts if we want to allow false progressivism in the faith, which gives in to a culture hostile to the Gospel, and lead us away from the Church and the Lord, or do we want to face the cost of being faithful to Jesus and his Church and be part of the new springtime of faith? May our hearts be open to the powerful love of God to accept the challenge of being faithful.

STEPHEN MINISTRY STATISTICS

Who are Stephen Ministers?

Stephen Ministers are members of your congregation trained to provide one-to-one, Christ-centered care.

Their role is to listen and care, not to counsel or advise. They have a compassionate heart for those who are hurting, and they're equipped with caring ministry skills by your congregation's Stephen Leaders. A Stephen Minister typically has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person once a week to listen, care, pray, encourage, and offer emotional and spiritual support. Stephen Ministers engage in twice-monthly supervision, led by their Stephen Leaders, to ensure that they are providing the best Christian care they can. Stephen Ministry is a confidential ministry. What a care receiver tells a Stephen Minister stays between the two of them. Even in supervision, the names of care receivers and specific details are never discussed.

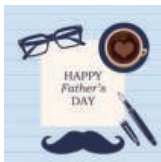

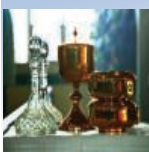
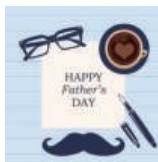
