#### House of Charity

As we begin the 2022 House of Charity-Bishop's Annual Appeal, I wanted to write to you a bit about the importance of this effort. For many years the House of Charity-Bishop's Annual Appeal has been the major source (and often the sole source) of funding for many of the social services the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Camden offers not just to her own members, but also to the community at large. A great many people have been helped both physically and spiritually through the House of Charity-Bishop's Annual Appeal. It is in this light, that I am asking your full support this year.

Over half of House of Charity funds go to social services throughout the Diocese of Camden. These funds help to subsidize the area nursing homes, Catholic Charities offices and special education services. The remaining funds support the vocations office and care of seminarians and elderly priests, lifelong faith formation, evangelization and outreach in the diocese, youth and campus ministry, the diocesan retreat house, and finally assistance of poor and needy parishes and schools. As in the past, we will a get ten percent return when we make our goal.

Or parish goal this year is \$155,500. It is quite a bit of money, but there are many, many people that need our help. We have been blessed by the Lord with many gifts, abilities, and opportunities. The House of Charity-Bishop's Annual Appeal campaign is a time when we can show the Lord we are grateful to him for his favorable providence. I know you have always shown your generosity to the parish of Holy Angels and you should be commended for that. At the same time, we also have a certain duty to reach out to the wider community as well. The House of Charity provides us with just the opportunity to do so.

So, I ask you to be as generous as possible this year, for there are a lot of people who count on us to help them. And I truly believe that the more we bring love and hope to those who don't find those gifts too often around them, the more the Lord will bless us with his love and hope.

Since COVID 19 and the changes to protocols and circumstances for serving those in residence, many of our EM's have been unable to serve as before.





#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS


