As usual, St. Patrick's, St. Matthew's and the Parish Center were decorated beautifully by our dedicated parishioners who give so much of their time to make sure everything looks so wonderful. Many thanks to them! Also, the music throughout the Triduum was spectacular (another blessing to have again!). The tremendous dedication and commitment given by our Musicians, Cantors and Choir, our Priests, Deacons, Altar Servers, Readers and all and the countless and often unrecognized heroes who did a fabulous job and really helped to make the celebration of the Lord's Passion and Resurrection glorious and profound. We have such a great parish made up of great people who love the Lord. Thank you all for once again making our Parish's Easter so beautiful!!!! Also, I can't fail to mention our Knights of Columbus and their helpers who braved the wind and the rain to weed and mulch around the property (see a photo later in the bulletin).

Parish Council Recommendations

We have a great Parish Council who care very much about our parish and our people. As the parish is becoming more active and with more people coming to Mass, at a recent Parish Council meeting they came up with some recommendations that I want to share with you. I think they are great ideas and hopefully, through our mutual cooperation, continue to grow this wonderful parish of Holy Angels.

We will be adding a few more handicapped parking spots in St. Patrick's parking lot. With this in mind, those with the energy of youth are asked to park across the street next to the parish office and save the spots next to the church for those who might have some trouble getting around.

Along the same line, those with the vigor of youth are asked to go up the steps into the balcony during the busy Masses of 4:00PM Saturday and 10:00AM Sunday to make space in the pews for our elderly folks. (We will be adding some lighting on the steps and better seating in the choir loft).

The cry room off to the left of the sanctuary is for parents and babies and space is limited. Please keep this in mind. It is not where you sit if you are sick, or you don't want to be in the main church and it is not for whole families. There have been occasions where parents who want to take an unruly child into the cry room so as not to distract others at Mass cannot do so because there is no room. Your understanding is appreciated!

Two final things. Firstly, there has been an increase of people going to Confession. That is tremendous and a great blessing! Sometimes the volume is so great that there are only five minutes or even less before Mass for the priest to vest and get ready. This is really not ideal since the priest doesn't really have much of a chance to prepare himself as he needs to celebrate the Mass as devoutly and reverently as he can. Therefore, we are going to start Confession earlier and end promptly at 3:45PM. See the bulletin for an update on when that will begin and make sure you get to Confession early so you don't get cut off.

Lastly, You will see a flyer in the bulletin this week for our parish volunteer appreciation dinner. If you volunteer in the parish you are welcome to attend!

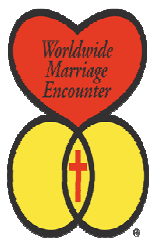
