

Passion / Palm Sunday





The great secular leader and speaker, Sir Winston Churchill once stated, "If you are going through hell, keep going." Although meaning to encourage the British people during the darkest moments of the Second World War, it is not too hard to "baptize" that comment to give it a Christian context, especially in the light the Cross of Jesus. Who could imagine, after a very severe beating, being made to carry not just the weight of the cross through the streets of Jerusalem, but also to carry it with the awareness that what you are carrying is also the instrument of your death. Then finally being nailed to the cross to hang on it until you die of asphyxiation, all in humiliating nakedness and excruciating pain.

How many times, throughout the length of the Passion, must the Lord have thought the same kinds of thoughts that he had in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Can't there be another way to do this?" "Can't I save the world in an easier way? In some way that requires a bit less on my part?" And yet in the fullness of his humanity, Jesus kept going through that hell so that he could free man precisely from the bonds of hell that prevented humanity from entering eternal life.

Jesus is a perfect model of perseverance to us. Praying before a Crucifix is a tremendous way to become plugged into how Jesus poured out his whole life for us in love and also be enabled to open our hearts to the grace we need to persevere in our lives and to continue to walk through the challenges and struggles we face.

As we remember today the Passion of Jesus as a prelude to Holy Week, I do hope that you, along with your family, can take the opportunity during Holy Week to participate in as many of the sacred celebrations as possible. The Holy Thursday Mass at 7:00PM where we celebrate the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the ministerial Priesthood, Good Friday when we fully celebrate the Passion of the Lord as well as the beautiful veneration of the Holy Cross at 3:00PM, and the Easter Vigil on Saturday at 8:00PM, the greatest celebration of our faith, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.






