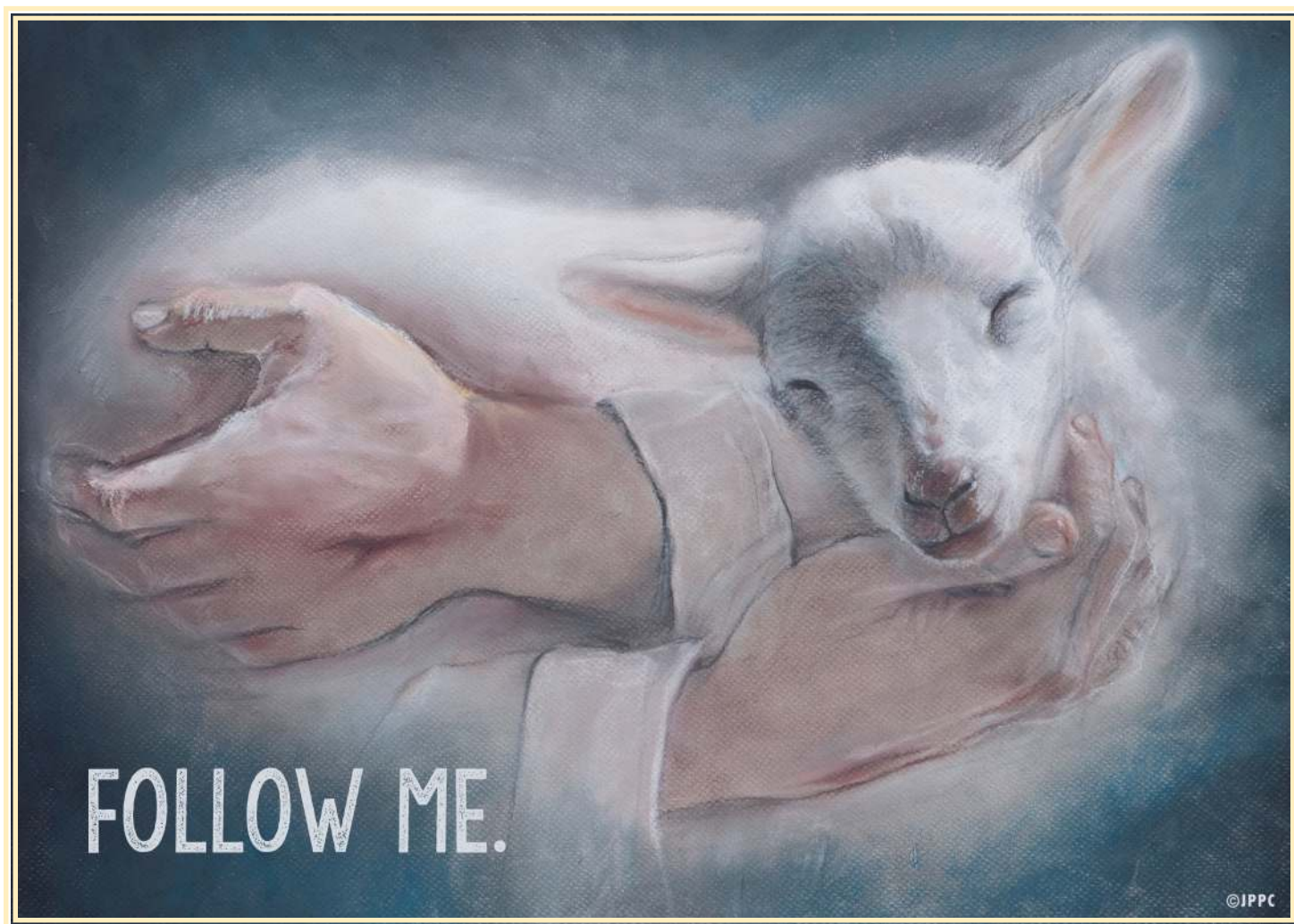

60th World Day of Prayer for Vocations - April 30, 2023

Today our Diocese, along with every other diocese in the world, is celebrating the 60th World Day of Prayer for Vocations. In 1963 Pope Paul VI designated Good Shepherd Sunday as World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, protects us as his flock and promises us the gift of eternal life. As his followers we are all called to remain faithful both to the grace of God and to the particular vocation to which God has called us: marriage, priesthood, diaconate, consecrated life, or the single life.

As much as each vocation is a gift from God, vocations spring up from the Church. Therefore we, as the Church, have a particular responsibility to foster vocations. We do this first and foremost by our witness of faith and the clear proclamation of that faith by the way we live our lives. Who would want to be a priest or a sister, or even get married in a church that does not live the faith it professes? The Second Vatican Council emphasized that the “universal call to holiness” is the primary vocation of every baptized person. It is from the personal holiness of the individual members which the particular vocations are discovered, developed, and nurtured. Thus our responsibility to promote vocations, first and foremost comes from the way we live our Christian faith.

While all vocations (marriage, priesthood, diaconate, consecrated life, and the single life) are necessary within the Church, there is a particular need right now to devote extra effort to promote vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. Again, we do this principally by faithfully practicing and living our Christian Faith, but also by seeing in others the potential for priestly and religious vocation and encouraging those individuals to be open to such a call. This is an effort of the whole church community that begins at an early age by creating a positive atmosphere in our families and community regarding priestly and religious vocations and to see and promote these vocations as worthy and attractive. At the same time, we need to continue to beg the Lord to send more laborers into his vineyard. Prayer is not something we do at the end of our effort to promote vocations but in the beginning and at all times. So let us pray not just today on this World Day for Vocations but at all times, that those who are being called by the Lord may hear the call and respond with a generous heart.

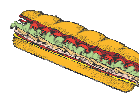

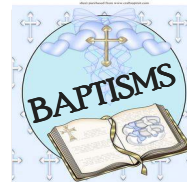

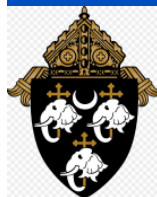
