

## Happy Father's Day!

Today, as on all recent Father's Days, many dads will be gathering around the television watching the final round of the U.S. Open Golf Championship, hoping that dinner will be timed so as not to interfere with the finish. It is a great way to spend the day, if you are a golfer!

I thought it nice to offer you a bit of history on the celebration of Father's Day. The idea for creating a day for children to honor their fathers began in Spokane, Washington. A woman by the name of Sonora Smart Dodd thought of the idea for Father's Day while listening to a Mother's Day sermon in 1909. Having been raised by her father, William Jackson Smart, after her mother died, Sonora wanted her father to know how special he was to her. It was her father that made all the parental sacrifices and was, in the eyes of his daughter, a courageous, selfless, and loving man. Sonora's father was born in June, so she chose to hold the first Father's Day Committee was formed in New York City. Father's Day was recognized by a Joint Resolution of Congress in 1956. In 1972, President Richard Nixon established a permanent national observance of Father's Day to be held on the third Sunday of June.

Although a civil holiday, it is fitting to honor our fathers as we have honored our mothers last month. Beyond all the hype and commercialization, it is still valuable to take the time to thank our fathers for their strength and guidance. It is through the paternal authority, derived from and parallel to divine Paternity, that fathers exercise their most important role. As God the Father looks over us so to do our fathers. Though not to rule over us, but to help us reach our full potential. The constant love and action of a good father is like the sun; ever present, ever active, but often unnoticed. May the Lord help us to be ever more aware of the great gift we have in our fathers, and may we remain ever grateful for their love and example. 


