

What is Our Catholic Vision?

The core of the Christian faith is that God took on our human nature in Jesus Christ. In order to save us from our sins and the eternal death that results from them, he gave his life on the cross. By his death he made satisfaction for our sins. By his resurrection from the dead he opened for us a way to eternal life in union with him for all who believe in him and through this belief, follow the way of love of and obedience to the Father.

This is the "Good News" of the Gospel. The Lord commanded us to spread this good news to all the corners of the world. It is the best thing anyone can hear; to be given a way to eternal life and happiness by faith in and obedience to Jesus Christ. So why is it that we can be so timid to share this good news? When there is an issue about our children or community in which we are concerned we rightly speak up, but what about Jesus? Why do we so easily tell all our friends about a great sale or some new gadget that is really cool, but find it such a struggle to talk about the Lord to them? If it takes approximately fifty million or so people to elect a president, why then, if there are sixty six million Catholics in the United States we can't or won't unite to promote the good of humanity by electing officials that promote God's truth? What are we afraid of? Have we lost our vision? Our faith? How much do we believe in the truth of the Gospel, of the Good News? Do we really believe that God's way is the best way?

We are the voices and the hands and the feet and the ears and eyes of Christ on earth. Our potential as Catholic Christians is enormous. Yet we seem to remain inactive. It is said that Admiral Yamamoto, the Japanese commander of the Pearl Harbor attack, stated "I fear all we have done is awaken a sleeping giant and filled him with a terrible resolve". What will awaken us to become truly committed to our faith and the Lord? The continued erosion of the dignity and value of human life? The destruction of marriage and family by its "redefinition"? The loss of religious freedom and conscience where we are compelled by law to violate our consciences? What will be enough for us to stand up and become the voice of the Lord in the world and in our country? How much suffering and loss of the meaning of humanity will it take? Or will we, like the fabled ostrich, bury our head in the sand as we await our fate?

Thanks be to God it is never too late. If we would consciously return to the Lord and his way, be courageous as a parent protecting a beloved child, we really could, assisted by God's grace, renew the face of the earth. The time is now for each and every one of us to renew our faith in Christ, to come back to him, to follow his way and receive his grace and his love. There is no program to implement, no structure to put in place, no magical bailout that can heal what is wrong in our society. It is only a moral renewal, a renewal of faith in and relationship with Jesus Christ that is the answer. In this way, united by our faith in and obedience to the Lord, we can live the life to which he has called us and begin to establish God's kingdom as he intended.






