The Solution to Evil

We look around the world, even when we look around our in own lives, we see a lot of bad things going on and it can make us a bit cynical or even afraid if we are not careful. But we cannot give into fear or discouragement or cynicism. All of these are really temptations from the Evil One to keep us away from the Lord. Our God is a God of love, who wants us to be happy and at peace. This happiness and peace come to us by being friends with God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The only thing that keeps us from friendship with God, either individually or as a community is sin. Sin is less about breaking some rule than it is an offense against God's love for us, a harming or breaking of our friendship with the Lord. The "badness" of betraying a friend is not just the offense of betrayal, but even more so is the loss of the friendship. It is the same with sin.

Luckily for us we have a way out of sin and its destructiveness. The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation...also known as Confession. The Sacrament of Penance is such a gift! It can be very hard to do -- it can be intimidating, embarrassing -- but once absolution is given, you will walk out of that confessional feeling like a trillion bucks. Christ, in His most Holy Wisdom, gave us this precious Sacrament to literally and truly bestow His grace upon us through His priests as a means of forgiving us and assuring us of His mercy and love for us. This psychological benefit of "feeling assured" and "clean again" stems not only from the supernatural fruits of the Sacrament, but from our human nature and our need to purge ourselves of those things that plague our consciences. Christ, the Great Physician, knows us well and knows that "confession is good for the soul," in both a supernatural and psychological sense. We are literally made new when forgiven of our sins. As the famous Catholic author G.K. Chesterton wrote, *"When a Catholic comes from confession, he does truly, by definition, step out into that dawn of his own beginning... in that brief ritual God has really remade him in His own image. He may be grey and gouty; but he is only five minutes old."*

In the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, we meet the Lord, who wants to grant forgiveness and the grace to live a renewed life in him. The Church sees confession as so important that she requires that every Catholic go at least once a year. The Church also encourages frequent confession in order to grow closer to Christ Jesus and his Body, the Church. By the grace of the Holy Spirit, we seek forgiveness and repentance, let go of patterns of sin, grow in the life of virtue, and witness to a joyful conversion. The late Pope Benedict XVI said it very eloquently.....*"Lastly, there is the [priest's] power of forgiveness. The Sacrament of Penance is one of the Church's precious treasures, since authentic world renewal is accomplished only through forgiveness. Nothing can improve the world if evil is not overcome. Evil can be overcome only by forgiveness. Certainly, it must be an effective forgiveness; but only the Lord can give us this forgiveness, a forgiveness that drives away evil not only with words but truly destroys it. Only suffering can bring this about and it has truly taken place with the suffering love of Christ, from whom we draw the power to forgive."*

While going to Confession can be scary, there is no need to be afraid. You come to Christ, the fountain of mercy and love in the Confessional. The priests will help you if you need, but above all remember you are talking to Christ and it is he whom you encounter in this Sacrament. If we want to be part of the solution of evil in the world we need, like Pope Benedict said, to start with forgiveness. Receiving it first from Jesus in the Sacrament of Penance, then offer it to others. Forgiveness...the fastest and most direct route to peace in our own lives and in our community and world.

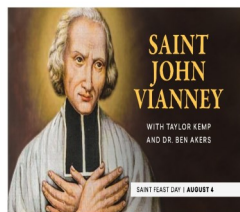
Ignatius of Loyola

This film brings to life the story of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits. Often called "The Saint of Second Chances," St. Ignatius was transformed from a self-obsessed sinner to a loyal and passionate soldier-saint.
