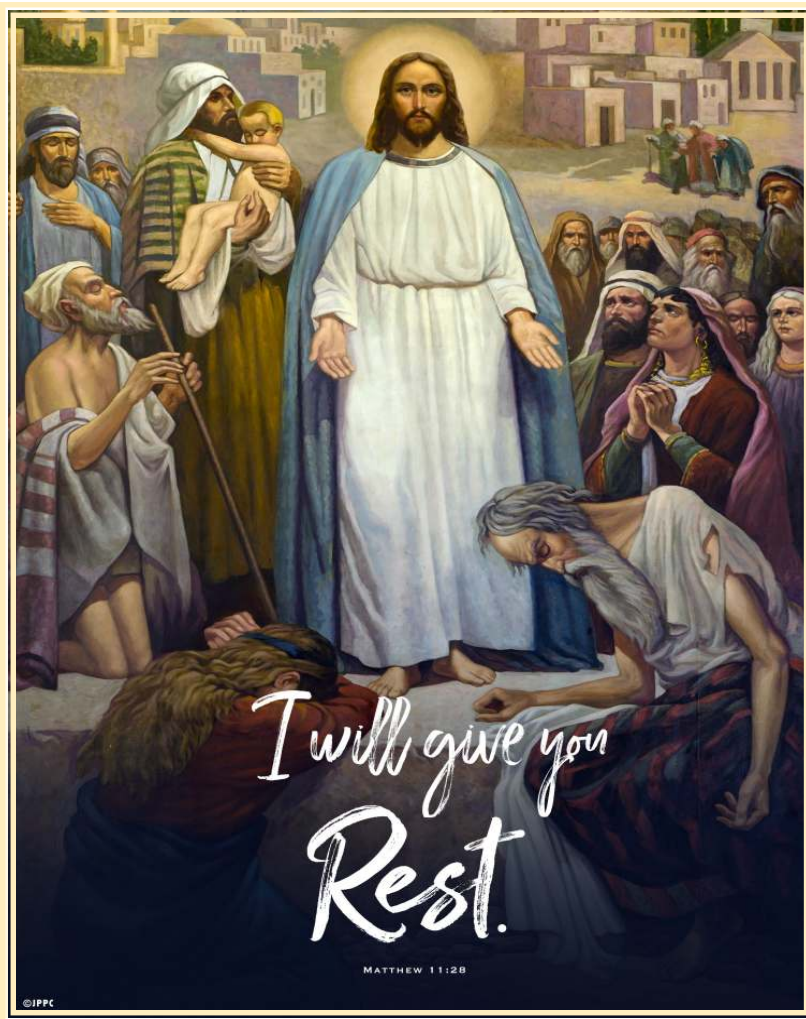

## Karen Carpenter

Karen Carpenter was born on March 2, 1950. Along with her brother, they formed the popular signing duo called “The Carpenters” in the 1970’s. They had a number of massive hits. For those who may not remember her, you most certainly hear her every Christmas with her famous song, “I’ll Be Home for Christmas.” Karen had an amazing voice with tremendous range and was also a very talented musician and drummer. Sadly, she died at the age of 32 on February 4, 1983. She died from complications due to anorexia. In fact, it was her death that brought public attention to the illness of anorexia. People with anorexia believe that they are fat, they “feel” that they are always overweight. Thus, they hardly eat, starving themselves and causing severe trauma to their bodies. Without treatment, both medical and psychological, they often die.

Why talk about such a tragedy? Well, an equal one is going on today in our world. If you ever saw a photo of Karen Carpenter, you would see that she wasn’t fat, quite the contrary. Nonetheless, that is what she truly believed about herself, that is how she felt about herself. While the root causes of anorexia might be difficult to fully determine, anorexia is an eating disorder, and, thankfully, is treated as such. When someone has an eating disorder, how do we respond? We try to get them help. Despite how certain the person is about being fat, they are wrong, and they need help to get through it. What parent would let their ten-year-old, or twelve-year-old, or fifteen-year-old child starve themselves to death because they thought it better to affirm their child’s false opinion about himself or herself than to do something about it?

Yet that is what we are doing today when we allow children to “change” their God given gender. Gender is not an opinion, it is a biological fact. We have been bullied over the past few years to be silent about what we know to be true. Silenced by an effective minority of very vocal and aggressive people who call anyone who disagrees with the concept of transgenderism - hateful, bigoted, unloving, etc.

Gender dysphoria is the general mental health term for not feeling comfortable with your biological gender. It is a very small percentage of the population. Did you know that 80% of prepubescent children who suffer from gender dysphoria grow out of it naturally? Even more if they receive counseling. The physical and emotional development that occurs during puberty can be challenging and confusing. This can, and does often, bring on issues with how comfortable people are with their bodies. If you add depression, loneliness, or any other psychological stresses, these feelings of body discomfort can easily be magnified. Why on earth do we as individuals and as a society and government support our emotionally struggling children to “identify” as a different gender, take puberty blockers, and in the worst cases have mutilating sexual reassignment surgery? That is not helping children, it is some of the worst child abuse possible. It is just like allowing an anorexic child to starve him or herself.

To be clear, if someone is an adult who suffers from gender dysphoria, and believes that sexual reassignment surgery is what will bring them peace, that is his or her choice, as sad as that is. But to promote this among children is not just tragic, but evil. And in some states, like New Jersey, public schools are required by law to affirm and support a child’s “preferred” gender expression and identity without the parent’s consent making the situation even worse. This, ultimately, is another diabolical attack against the family against which we should be fighting with all our might rather than cowering in fear to the loud minority. May God give us the strength and courage to promote and defend what is right and good and true before there is no more right and good and true.

nurture the military and their families.*



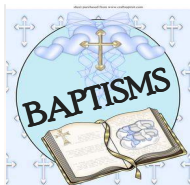
## DIAPER DRIVE FOR LOCAL FAMILIES
