March for Life

This past Friday was the March for Life in Washington, D.C. One may ask, "why is there still a march if Roe v. Wade has been overturned?" Even with the wonderful blessing that Roe v. Wade was overturned means that a tremendous battle has been won, the war is far from over. The overturning of *Roe* means that instead of abortion being a federally protected right, it is now transferred to state law. That is, it is up to each individual state to determine its own abortion laws. The critical and necessary work to build a culture of life in the United States of America is not finished. Rather, it is focused differently. Sadly, the number of abortions annually is still well over 900,000 each year, and that number is expected to decrease only by roughly 200,000 each year in a post-Roe America. Meaning there will still likely be 700,000+ in the United States. In particular, here in New Jersey, we have a state legislature and governor who are extremely hostile to the life of the unborn. In 2022, right after Roe v. Wade was overturned, the Governor and the legislature enacted even more legislation to even more radically expand abortion in New Jersey. We cannot ignore this or forget this. We still have much work to do here in our state, to fight for the baby New Jerseyans in the womb and to change hearts and minds and help everyone embrace the dignity and value of every human life, including those in the womb. Do not think this is over. Your prayers and sacrifices for the unborn and their moms are still needed. At the same time, we must continue just, ardent, peaceful and loving pro-life political activism until all life is valued.

Church Envelopes

Once again, it is time to review our church envelop use in our parish. Our envelope expense is thousands of dollars a year and there are a good portion of our registered parishioners who receive church envelopes but do not use them for various reasons. Shortly, we will perform our yearly purge of those who do not use envelopes. Don't worry, "purge" as in no longer sending envelopes, not purging from the parish list! If for some reason you stop getting envelopes in the next few months and still want them, please make sure to call the parish office. Thank you.

Being on Time for Mass

With train tracks that have frequent trains just feet away from our church everyone is going to get stopped every so often on their way to Mass and end up late. There is no doubt that the Lord understands that. Families with small children, the elderly that may have slowed down a bit, and for all kinds of other reasons one might be late for Mass. Being late for Mass one out of 15 or 20 times is no big deal. However, if one is frequently or regularly late for Mass, then I would say that is something to look into. Entering the church while Mass has begun can be distracting to both the people at Mass as well as the priest celebrating it. And regularly being late, without a serious reason, is disrespectful to your fellow Mass goers, the priest, and to the Lord. It certainly is not spiritually advantageous to come to Mass late, rather it is the opposite. This is especially true for Daily Mass goers. So if you find yourself regularly late for Mass, look to the reason why. If leaving the house 5 or 10 minutes sooner will help, please do. Being on time for Mass shows your reverence and sincerity and commitment. Everyone will be grateful, including your soul, and especially the Lord!


