Keeping Holy the Sabbath Day

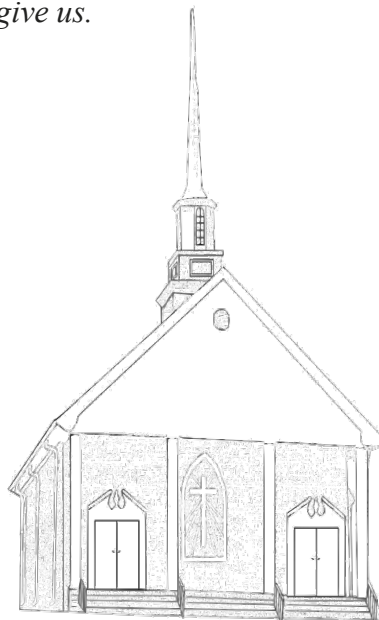
In Sunday Angelus address, during the time Pope Benedict XVI in office, he called on the faithful gathered in St. Peter's Square to live Sunday not only as a day of rest and of the family, but above all as a day "to dedicate to the Lord." Addressing thousands of pilgrims, the Holy Father emeritus called to mind the Sunday Gospel of St. Luke, where Jesus enters the synagogue on the Sabbath. The Pope noted that Jesus Christ, as a devout believer, "does not neglect the weekly liturgical rhythm." Continuing his commentary on the Gospel, the former Pope reflected on the Lord's words upon reading the passage from the prophet Isaiah: "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing" (Lk. 4:21).

"St. Cyril of Alexandria states that the 'today,' placed between the first and last coming of Christ, is linked to the believer's capacity to listen and reform his life," the Benedict said. "But in a still more radical sense Jesus himself is the 'today' of salvation in history because he brings the fullness of redemption. The term 'today,' very dear to St. Luke, brings us to the preferred Christological title of the same evangelist, namely, 'savior'. Already in the infancy narratives, it is presented in the words of the angel to the shepherds: "Today, in the city of David, there is born for you a Savior, Christ the Lord".

Pope emeritus Benedict continued his address reminding the faithful to live Sunday as a day dedicated to the Lord, where participating in the Eucharist, "we are nourished by the Body and Blood of Christ and by his Word of life." The Holy Father also stated that the Gospel invites us to reflect on our capacity to listen to God. "Before speaking about God and with God we must listen to him, and the Church's liturgy is the 'school' of this listening to the Lord who speaks to us," Benedict said. "In the end he tells us that every moment can become a 'today' that is propitious for our conversion. Every day can become the today of salvation because salvation is the story that continues for the Church and for each disciple of Christ. This is the Christian sense of "carpe diem" (seize the day): welcome the today in which God calls you to grant you salvation!"

If we want God to have more of an impact in our lives, we need to first start with Sunday. Being faithful to Sunday Mass is essential; while at Mass, we need to our best to participate fully. And we also need to remember to do some sort of family prayer together (reading Sacred Scripture together, praying the Rosary or part of the Rosary, etc.). Spending time with the Lord on the Lord's Day" is a surefire recipe for having us and our families come closer to Him and receive all of the love and blessings He wishes to give us.
