Mortal Sin vs. Venial Sin

From time to time people ask me the difference between these two categories of sin and I would to take the opportunity to review them. Before we get into detail regarding this issue I think it is important to note that ALL sin is bad since in some way it draws us away from the Lord. We are called to holiness and “to be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect” (Mt 5:48). Of course we cannot become perfect, we cannot become holy except through the grace of God, yet on our part we need to strive with the gifts that the Lord does give us to avoid those actions which are contrary to holiness and contrary to our relationship with God. Sin is much more than merely a violation of one of God’s laws or commandments; it is essentially a rejection or betrayal of love. When we sin we violate either our love for God, our love for others, or even our (proper) love for ourselves.

There are some sins, some violations of love that only harm our relationship with God and others. As if, merely “harming” as opposed to “killing” is somehow “good”. This is why all sin is bad, because even the slightest sin will damage our relationship with God and can set us up for further and more serious sins in the future. The category of sin that only wounds our relationship with God is called Venial Sin (“venial” comes from the Latin word, “vulnera” which means “wound” because Venial Sin wounds the soul). Venial sin does not destroy the divine life within the soul, though it diminishes it. Venial sin is the failure to observe necessary moderation, in lesser matters of the moral law, or in grave matters acting without full knowledge or complete consent. No amount of Venial Sins can ever “add up” to a Mortal Sin, but a lack of repentance of Venial Sin can set the environment for graver sins in the future. Although we are not obliged to confess Venial Sins in the Sacrament of Penance we are encouraged to do so since in addition to forgiveness of sin we also receive in the Sacrament of Penance special graces to amend our lives in the particular area we mention.

There is also a category of sin that results in the complete turning away from the love of God that it destroys the divine life within the soul of the sinner. This is Mortal Sin. Mortal sins are so grave that we sever our bond, our friendship with God when we commit them (“mortal” comes from the Latin word “mors” which means “death” because Mortal Sin kills the soul). We believe that if a person dies in the state of Mortal Sin, because he or she has severed his or her relationship with God, then the person will be estranged from God for eternity, better known as Hell. While God is ultimately the judge and is the only one who can look into a person’s soul and understand perfectly each action we commit, we still have the ability to categorize Mortal Sins. While we can say, “If these conditions are present, then it is a mortal sin”, it is still up to God to determine whether the conditions are present. But we do have the ability to discuss them and even though God is the ultimate judge, we also have the ability to assess the moral evil of an action even if God may not hold the person morally responsible.

Next week I will review the conditions for a Mortal Sin.

RCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

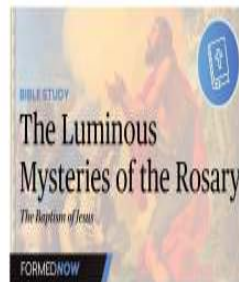
