The Lord said to me: You are my Son; this day I have begotten you. (Ps 2:7)

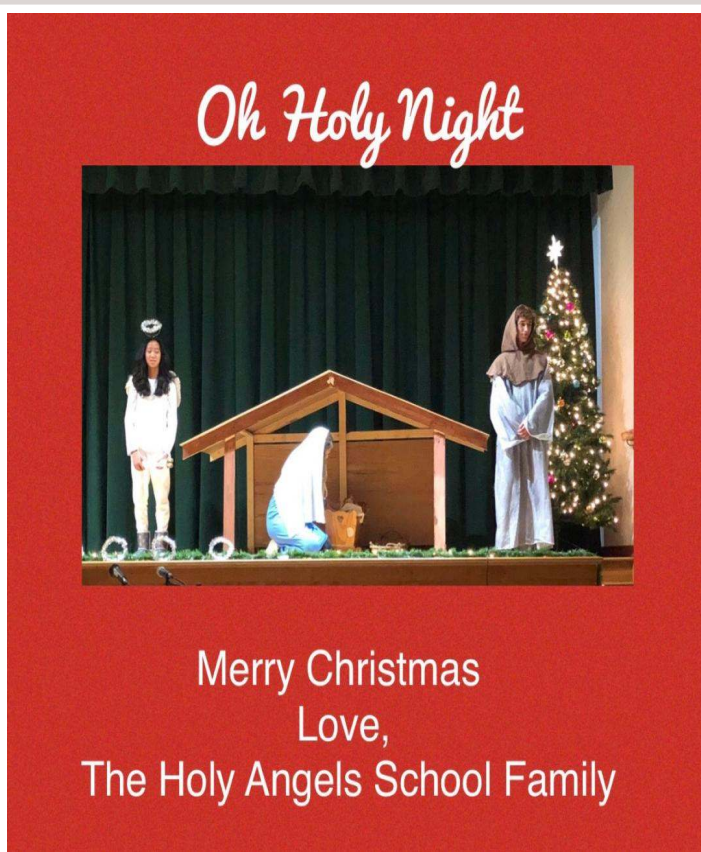
