## Continuing into Advent

As we continue to move through our celebration of Advent and await the arrival of Christ our Savior at Christmas, it is a good time to reflect upon the challenge that we as believers have in participating in the “New Evangelization” called for by all of our recent popes, Pope St. John Paul II, Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis. Evangelization, as you know, is spreading the Gospel message of love and salvation to the world.

Amidst the often frantic pace of the Advent/Christmas season, it is traditionally also a time for getting together with family and friends. There is something about this festive season that seems to soften the human heart. One might say there is a special outpouring of God’s grace into the world. Because of this, we are offered a great opportunity to bring the Gospel message to those who may not normally be open to hearing it.

Seeking to be reconciled with those from whom we have been separated, forgiving past hurts, extending true hospitality to those we do not normally get along with, generously sharing our material goods with the less fortunate - these are concrete ways that we can make the love of God known to others. In the end, proclaiming the Gospel is not just putting forth propositions to be believed but also in making known to others the love of God. This comes from the idea that our faith is principally not about belief in a series of doctrinal statements as much as it is belief in and friendship with the person of Christ. It is not that the “what” of our faith, that is the content of the faith isn’t important, but it is important only in reference to the “who” of our faith, Jesus Christ our Lord.

So, in showing love to others we are showing Christ, who is Love, to them. It is perhaps the most effective way to spread the Gospel. As much as I hope and pray that the Lord comes into your hearts anew this Christmas, it is also my wish that you make the most of this chance to bring the love of God to others this Christmas. In doing so, you will not only be cooperating in a most important work of the Church, but also, I believe, opening yourself up to an even greater share in God’s love for yourselves.

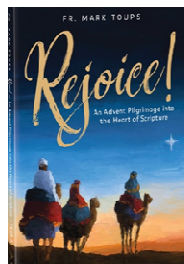

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a sacramental process that prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church. Persons who complete the process receive the sacraments of Baptism (if not yet baptized), First Eucharist, and Confirmation.

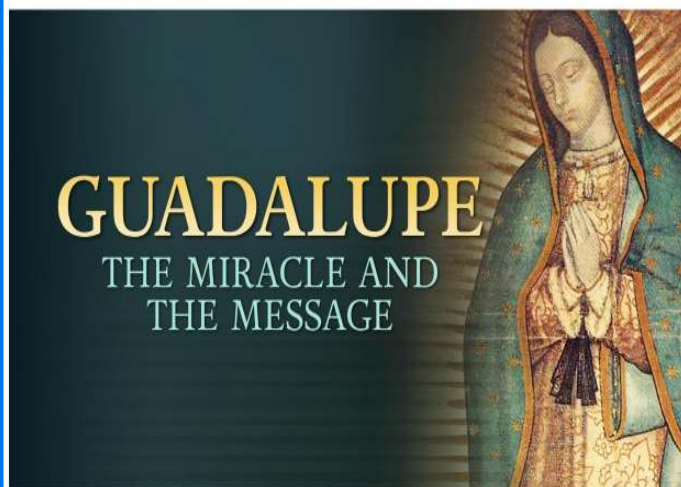
RCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

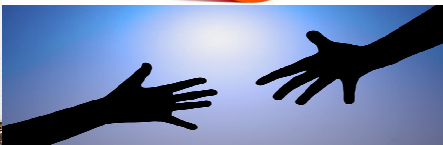
