The Glass of Water



There is a sixteen-ounce glass on the table and it contains eight ounces of water. An optimist sees the glass of water as "half-filled". A pessimist sees the same glass as "half-empty". So, what is it? In reality, I think we can say that the glass is both half full and half empty. While the optimist only sees the positive - the "fullness", and the pessimist only sees the negative - the "emptiness", there is a third perspective. This third perspective acknowledges the fullness and the emptiness of the glass both present together. Often, we say this position is the "realist" position. Thus, the realist would say that the glass is both half full and half empty. Although "realism" is often contrasted with "idealism," I find it more helpful to see that a realist position provides an alternative to both extremes rather than just one.

Exactly what to call a sixteen-ounce glass filled with eight ounces of water isn't really a big deal. However, if we think about our spiritual lives and the perspective we bring with us into our relationship with God as well as others, that perspective can and does have some pretty significant influence. If we are all positive all of the time with respect to our relationship to God, we can overlook potential dangers to ourselves and also not have much incentive to challenge ourselves to grow in love and holiness and closeness to God. On the other hand, if we are all negative all the time, we can easily become depressed and discouraged. This also can leave us without incentive to challenge ourselves to grow in love and holiness and closeness to God. It's interesting that both extremes can produce the same negative effect.

But a perspective that accepts the good and recognizes the action of God in our lives, while at the same time acknowledges one's sinfulness and weakness enables the person to be consoled and encouraged as well as being challenged to do and be better.

We are sinners redeemed by Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. Not because of our good, but because of the love of God. We deserve death because of our sins but are offered life through Christ. While it might be a struggle sometimes to see both the positive and the negative existing at the same time, it is both the most accurate and also provides the greatest opportunity to grow in holiness and in our friendship with God.

Each of us has a particular perspective that comes easier than the other. That's ok, it's part of our unique personality and make up given to us by God. Our job, so to speak, is to not let the dominate perspective overcome and engulf us. We do this by consciously and explicitly acknowledging both the emptiness and the fullness in us and around us, as difficult as it might be sometimes. Both are present and both need to be admitted if we are going to reach the fullness that God has created us for.

The Life and Justice Ministry will resume its meetings on the last Monday of the **odd** number months at 7PM in the Worship Center upstairs classroom.



RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS


