

The Holy Eucharist

The Second Vatican Council calls the Most Holy Eucharist the "source and summit of Christian worship". The Holy Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Our faith believes that the Holy Eucharist, or Holy Communion, is not merely a symbol of Jesus Christ but really *is* Jesus. His whole self. That is, each particle of the Sacred Host, each drop of the Precious Blood, is entirely Jesus, not a part of Him.

At Mass, the bread and wine are offered to the Father in the very same manner as Jesus offered up bread and wine at the Last Supper. During that sacred meal, the first Mass, he spoke the words that every priest says at every Mass, "This is my body...this is my blood." As the Lord gave himself to his Apostles at the Last supper, he gives himself to us at Mass. We believe that through the words of Christ spoken through the priest at the Consecration, the bread and wine are transformed into the body and blood of Christ. We call that process transubstantiation, where the substance of the bread and wine are changed into the substance of Christ, his very own living and true presence. Although still appearing to be bread and wine, the true substance is now Jesus. That is why it is so important that during the Consecration, we give our fullest attention to what is happening on the altar; Jesus is transforming the bread and wine to himself. It is not the time for a bathroom trip or a conversation, it is the time to lovingly adore and acknowledge the presence of our Savior in our midst.

While we may for ease of description say, "the Body of Christ" or "the Blood of Christ" it is important to remember that, as mentioned earlier, "each particle of the Sacred Host, each drop of the Precious Blood, is entirely Jesus". Thus there is no actual distinction with regard to the presence of Jesus in the Host or the Precious Blood, he is equally and fully present in both. Therefore when receive Holy Communion, we don't get "more Jesus" if we receive under both species (the Host and the Precious Blood), for when we receive the Holy Eucharist in just the Host, or just the Precious Blood, or both, we receive the full presence of our Lord into our souls.

Since it is our faith that we are actually receiving the Lord into our souls when we receive Holy Communion at Mass, we need to constantly remind ourselves that we need to be spiritually prepared as well as suitably prepared to receive him. If we are conscious of having committed a serious or mortal sin (such as missing Mass without a grave reason) and have broken our communion with the Lord, we should not receive the Holy Eucharist until we have reestablished our communion with him through the sacrament of Penance. Otherwise our "communion" is a mockery and a sacrilege. Jesus has given us the greatest gift when he gave us himself. We have the tremendous opportunity to receive him at each Mass. May we do so with the utmost reverence and love so that the fullness of what he offers us may be ours.


