

The Solemnity of the Annunciation

Although we celebrate the Annunciation as a major feast day of the Church, we don't get a chance to talk about it too much because it is normally eclipsed a bit due to its closeness to Easter. This year with Easter as late as it is, we are provided with a nice opportunity to reflect a bit more deeply on this great feast that we celebrated two days ago.

The story of the Annunciation is told in Luke's gospel. At the Annunciation, the angel Gabriel announces to Mary that she will conceive a Son, and his name will be Jesus. His greeting, "Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you" has

echoed down through the ages in many prayers, and makes up the first half of the "Hail Mary." In the meeting, Mary is initially confused as to how she will bear God's Son, seeing as she is a virgin. The angel Gabriel then explains that the Holy Spirit will come upon on her. This is why when we recite the Nicene creed we say "by the power of the Holy Spirit, [Jesus] was born of the Virgin Mary and became man." Thus, the Feast of the Annunciation is actually the beginning of Jesus' miraculous life, starting with Mary conceiving Jesus by the Holy Spirit's power. The date of this feast is March 25th, exactly nine months before we celebrate Christmas and the birth of Jesus on December 25th, chosen no doubt to reinforce our faith in the conception of Jesus took place by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Mary's response to the angel, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your word," is a statement of humble faith, and a model for how we are to respond when God calls us to do what seems impossible to us or is hard for us to understand. The Catechism addresses the significance of Mary's faith in relation to her role as Christ's mother: "By pronouncing her "yes" at the Annunciation and giving her consent to the Incarnation, Mary was already collaborating with the whole work her Son was to accomplish. She is mother wherever he is Savior and head of the Mystical Body." (CCC 973)

As one of our principle models of faith, Mary clearly shows us that our response to God needs to be one that is based on trust, often going beyond our own thoughts and feelings. We say yes to God because we believe in his love for us, we trust that he desires our good and so we submit our will to his. Sometimes we are challenged by the Lord to accept something that we don't understand or that we don't like. The Blessed Mother, sinless and holy as she was when visited by the angel Gabriel, still had to make an act of faith in saying yes to what God was asking her. I can only imagine how difficult that moment was in our Lady's mind and heart; not just because she didn't fully understand what was happening to her, but also because she probably realized that many others wouldn't understand as well.

Mary is such a great example to us in faith. Not only did she freely submit her will to God's and to trust in him and his love, but she did so despite not fully understanding what was being asked of her. And no doubt our Lady also understood the opposition she would receive as a now pregnant unmarried girl without an explanation as to why she was pregnant out of wedlock.

How much of ourselves are we willing to submit to God? How disposed are we to endure the potential challenges that we may face because of our acceptance of his will in our lives? Dear Mary, whose "yes" to God enabled the world to be saved through the incarnation of Jesus Christ, pray for us that we too may have the same faith and trust in God to say yes to his will for us in our lives as you did at the Annunciation. Amen.






