

### Pope Francis: The Path of Jesus Always Brings Us to Happiness

In an address at Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome, the Holy Father mentioned that even if we face trials, if we follow the way of Jesus, we will find happiness. The Holy Father was reflecting on this week's Gospel, the Gospel of the second Sunday of Lent, which recounts the event of the Transfiguration, when Jesus gives Peter, James, and John a glimpse of his glory, to confirm them in the faith and encourage them to follow Him and the path of the Cross.

"Jesus doesn't deceive us," Pope Francis stated. Although we, like the Apostles at times, can be scared and doubtful, this should never deter us from following our Lord. Pope Francis stressed that when we follow Him, we will always find happiness. "The Lord," he rejoiced, "is able to transform us!"

The message for the disciples and for us, Pope Francis said, is this: "Listen to him! Listen to Jesus. He is the Savior: follow him." Listening to Christ, in fact, involves taking the logic of his Paschal Mystery, which, he said, requires us making our lives a gift of love to others, in docile obedience to the will of God. "What we must have is an attitude of detachment from worldly things and interior freedom," the Pope stressed.

In other words, he continued, we must be prepared to lose our lives, in order to realize God's divine plan of salvation for all mankind. Before leading the faithful in the Angelus prayer, the Holy Father encouraged the faithful to stop and contemplate the face of Jesus "in order to accept the message," "put it into our own lives," and "be transformed in love."

As we continue throughout our Lenten pilgrimage, it's important that we keep a positive spirit. We may have "cheated" here and there in our Lenten discipline, had that piece of cake, not prayed as much as we have planned, not been as generous to the poor and needy as we should. Even still, we have plenty of time left to make a good Lent. No need to ever be discouraged. As Pope Francis stated, we need to listen to the Lord and trust him. We do that by consciously disengaging ourselves from the world and its "stuff" and making the time to spend time with the Lord in prayer. That is the only way that we will be able to hear Him enough to be able to listen to Him. Continue to have a good and holy Lent.

#### Come and Visit Our Lord

Jesus, we know, loves us so much that he gave his life for us on the Cross and continues to give himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. He greatly desires to be united to us. One of the ways we can respond to this is to spend time in the Eucharistic presence of Jesus. Don't forget that on Mondays there is a holy hour of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 7:00PM-8:00PM, and on Fridays there is Adoration from after the 9:00AM Mass until 7:00PM.

As we continue in our Eucharistic Renewal, remember that our Lord is truly present in Holy Eucharist and spending time in his presence is a tremendous opportunity to come closer to the Him. As I often say, the most precious thing we possess is time; how we spend it says more about us than how we spend our money. If we want to be close to the Lord, like any other friendship, we need to spend time with him for our friendship to develop. He patiently awaits us.

Come see what countless saints have learned; the more time we spend with the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, the more peace we will have, the more effective we will be in our day to day activity, the better our decisions will be, and the more strength we will have to endure the trials that come our way in life. Who can argue with that? Come, visit Jesus and see.


