

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI on Taking Up One's Cross

Taking up one's cross and following Christ is part of entering into Lent, and the only path in life that leads to the victory of love and peace over hatred and violence, stated Benedict XVI in one of his Lenten addresses some years ago. The Pope had reflected on what it means to live the liturgical season of Lent. Entering into Lent, he said, "means to enter into a time of particular commitment in the spiritual combat that opposes us to the evil present in the world, in each one of us and around us. It means to look evil in the face and dispose oneself to fight against its effects, above all against its causes, right up to its ultimate cause, Satan. "It means not unloading the problem of evil onto others, onto society, onto God, but recognizing one's own responsibility and consciously taking it upon oneself." The Holy Father said that it's also a time to take up one's cross and follow Christ. The cross, he added, is the "opportunity to follow Christ and in this way acquire strength in the battle against sin and evil." The Pontiff concluded: "Entering into Lent therefore means renewing the personal and communal decision to face evil together with Christ. The way of the cross is in fact the only way that leads to the victory of love over hate, of sharing over egoism, of peace over violence. Seen in this way, Lent is truly an occasion for determined ascetic and spiritual commitment founded upon the grace of Christ."

In the fight against sin in our lives, as difficult as it may be – and hence the Holy Father's reminder of the Cross - we need to remember that it is definitely a fight worth fighting. As St. Justin Martyr tells us, "To yield and give in to our sinful desires is the lowest form of slavery; to rule over such base desires in the only true freedom."

Taking up one's cross and fighting against evil is even more timely today as we continue to witness the bloodshed and suffering in the Ukraine due to the unprovoked invasion by Russia. It is not just our prayerful support that the Ukrainians need, and I would say the Russians as well; they also need us to fight. While the physical war might be in a country thousands of miles away from us, the same battle with evil is present here and now in front of us and in our hearts. So, the more that we fight against evil present in front of us, and, with the aid of the Lord, push back against Satan, the more we will at the same time bring to bear God's grace and mercy against the evil in the Ukraine.






LECTIO: THE CASE FOR JESUS

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS



Each Saturday **during Lent** prior to the 4PM Mass, beginning March 5th. Service begins at 3:25PM and should be about 15 minutes.

You are invited to come and pray the Evening Liturgy of the Hours, Vespers, with the Holy Angels community and the universal Church in preparation for Easter.

If you come to the 4PM Mass, please plan to arrive a little bit earlier and experience this prayer of the Church.

Vespers is one of the "Hours," the evening prayer of the Church, that are prayed daily. "The Liturgy of the Hours" are prayed by the ordained ministers, (bishop, priests and deacons) as well as many religious men and women, and the monastic orders. Lay persons in recent times have become more involved with praying "the Liturgy of the Hours".

Most of the prayers in the Liturgy of the Hours come from the Psalms. Jesus prayed the very Psalms that we now recite. Mary most likely taught him the Psalms. Jesus quoted the psalms in his preaching and teaching. He recited them at key moments in his life to explain the meaning of his life experience. After the resurrection, the first Christians easily recognized the person of Jesus reflected in these Hebrew

You are invited to participate and pray these deeply moving reflections of humanity reaching out to God. Perhaps you can make this a Lenten prayer to deepen your faith this year.
