## The continuity of faith: Pre-Vatican II, Vatican II, or Post-Vatican II?

I always smile when I hear the terms "Pre-Vatican II" or "Post-Vatican II" or some variant. For it confirms the difficulty Pope Emeritus Benedict expressed in his beautiful reflection some years ago on the fortieth anniversary of the Second Vatican Council. In the reflection he asked the question, "*Why has the implementation of the Council, in large parts of the Church, thus far been so difficult?*" The Holy Father responds to this question in one of the most penetrating and insightful analyses ever given of the Second Vatican Council. I have edited it for length below while I trust faithfully maintaining the content. It is worthwhile to read the full address which can be found at <http://www.vatican.va>, under Pope Benedict XVI's 2005 Christmas address to the Roman Curia.

Now, back to the answer to the question, "*Why has the implementation of the Council, in large parts of the Church, thus far been so difficult?*" Pope Benedict XVI continues,

"Well, it all depends on the correct interpretation of the Council or - as we would say today - on its proper hermeneutics, the correct key to its interpretation and application. The problems in its implementation arose from the fact that two contrary hermeneutics (interpretations) came face to face and quarreled with each other. One caused confusion, the other, silently but more and more visibly, bore and is bearing fruit.

On the one hand, there is an interpretation that I would call "a hermeneutic of discontinuity and rupture"; it has frequently availed itself of the sympathies of the mass media, and also one trend of modern theology. On the other, there is the "hermeneutic of reform", of renewal in the continuity of the one subject-Church which the Lord has given to us. She is a subject which increases in time and develops, yet always remaining the same, the one subject of the journeying People of God.

The hermeneutic of discontinuity risks ending in a split between the pre-conciliar Church and the post-conciliar Church. It asserts that the texts of the Council as such do not yet express the true spirit of the Council. It claims that they are the result of compromises in which, to reach unanimity, it was found necessary to keep and reconfirm many old things that are now pointless. However, the true spirit of the Council is not to be found in these compromises but instead in the impulses toward the new that are contained in the texts. These innovations alone were supposed to represent the true spirit of the Council, and starting from and in conformity with them, it would be possible to move ahead. Precisely because the texts would only imperfectly reflect the true spirit of the Council and its newness, it would be necessary to go courageously beyond the texts and make room for the newness in which the Council's deepest intention would be expressed, even if it were still vague. In a word: it would be necessary not to follow the texts of the Council but its spirit. In this way, obviously, a vast margin was left open for the question on how this spirit should subsequently be defined and room was consequently made for every whim. The nature of a Council as such is therefore basically misunderstood. In this way, it is considered as a sort of constituent that eliminates an old constitution and creates a new one.

The hermeneutic of discontinuity is countered by the hermeneutic of reform, as it was presented first by Pope John XXIII who stated that the Council wishes "*to transmit the doctrine, pure and integral, without any attenuation or distortion*". And he continues: "*Our duty is not only to guard this precious treasure, as if we were concerned only with antiquity, but to dedicate ourselves with an earnest will and without fear to that work which our era demands of us...*". It is necessary that "*adherence to all the teaching of the Church in its entirety and preciseness...*" be presented in "*faithful and perfect conformity to the authentic doctrine, which, however, should be studied and expounded through the methods of research and through the literary forms of modern thought. The substance of the ancient doctrine of the deposit of faith is one thing, and the way in which it is presented is another...*", retaining the same meaning and message.

**Reflection question: Are we discontinuous or a reformer? Do we accept and appreciate the full heritage of our faith and seek to faithfully and authentically present it anew, or do we seek to cut off the past and begin something novel and different? – Fr. B**

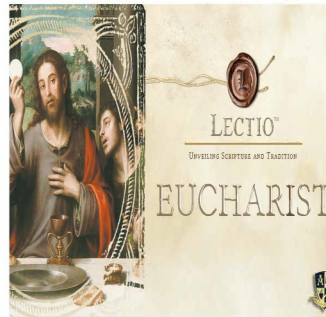

Bishops of the Ecclesiastical Province of Newark have decided to permanently transfer the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the following Sunday. **Effective this year.**

Therefore, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, replacing the liturgical celebration and readings of the Seventh Sunday of Easter—including the celebration of the Liturgy of the Hours.

Thursday, May 26, 2022 will be the Thursday of the Sixth week of Easter - the memorial of Saint Philip Neri.

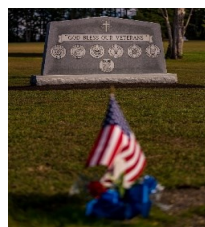
