Helpful Reminders for Mass!

In the wake of our recent Parish Council meeting, I offer you some of the things that came up in our meeting. While I put some of these in a few weeks ago, I just want to reiterate them since it was recommended that these be placed in the bulletin to facilitate and smooth our worship at Mass.

Cry Room

Everyone is encouraged to remember that the cry room is for babies and young children who are not able be present in the main body of the church. Please be sensitive in recognizing that the cry room is not for adults who are ill and/or for those who do not wish to sit in the main body of the Church. If you are too ill to come to Mass, the Lord understands, it is better to stay home than to expose vulnerable babies and children to illness.

The Most Holy Eucharist for the Handicapped/Elderly

There is no need for those who come to Mass and have difficulty walking to have to walk from the back of the church to receive the Holy Eucharist. Everyone is asked to leave the first two pews in the front of the church for the elderly and those who might have difficulty getting around. At every Mass Holy Communion will be brought first to the front section.

Additional considerations for the Handicapped/Elderly

- 1. We will be adding a few more handicapped parking spots in St. Patrick's parking lot. With this in mind, those with the energy of youth are asked to park across the street next to the parish office and save the spots next to the church for those who might have some trouble getting around.
- 2. Along the same line, those with the vigor of youth are asked to go up the steps into the balcony during the busy Masses of 4:00PM Saturday and 10:00AM Sunday to make space in the pews for our elderly folks. (We will be adding some lighting on the steps and better seating in the choir loft).

Offertory Gifts

If you wish to bring up the gifts at the offertory procession, you are encouraged to do so! This is true especially if you have requested the Mass; please see one of the ushers when you arrive in church so that they make sure you have the opportunity bring up the gifts. Please be conscious of having reverent, modest attire when bringing up the gifts.
