

Discontinuity vs. Reform, part II

Last week, I offered a portion of Pope Emeritus Benedict's analysis on the difficulties that have been experienced by the Church in the implementation of the Second Vatican Council. In his reflection, the Holy Father stated that these difficulties center on the "hermeneutic" of Vatican II. "Hermeneutic" sounds like a big word, but it really isn't. It is just the Greek work for "interpretation" (The root word of hermeneutics comes from the Greek god, Hermes, the god often depicted with winged feet. It was he who had the task of delivering messages from Mt. Olympus - where the gods lived - to the mortal world; that is, he interpreted for the mortals the messages of the gods). So, what Pope Benedict is saying is that the difficulties that the Church is having in the implementation of the Second Vatican Council centers on how one interprets the meaning and purpose of the Council.

For those who see Vatican II as "discontinuous" or a break with the past councils, will look at the teachings of the Council much differently that those who see the Council in continuity with the teachings of the Church dating back to the Apostles. The former seek to detach the Church from the past and have it develop in a completely new direction, free from any historical constraint. On the other hand, and the proper way to look at the Second Vatican Council according to Benedict, is to see the Council and its teachings precisely in the light of the past. To draw on the rich heritage of the past and to "re-present" the Church and her message in a way that is accessible to the contemporary world. This is the true nature of reform.

So when we look to Second Vatican Council we need to see it as part of the same tradition and in continuity with the councils before it: Vatican I, the Council of Trent, the multiple Councils of Nicaea, the Council of Ephesus, and all the rest going all the way back to the Council of Jerusalem in 70 A.D. at which the Apostles were present. It would be a grave mistake and a terrible tragedy to think that we no longer need our past. Our faith is the same and will always be the same. It has been given to us by the Lord and it is he who continues to guide the Church through the Holy Spirit. In the end, if we respect and are faithful to the rich heritage of our Church, we can move confidently into the future, knowing the perennial truths of the Gospel, the precious inheritance of our past, and the Lord's love and grace will lead the Church to be an ever more effective instrument of salvation for the world.




