

The Month of Mary

This weekend forty-two of our children received the Most Holy Eucharist for the first time. We are so happy for them! And it is a perfect segue to write about devotion to the Blessed mother following mention of the Holy Eucharist. Christ our Lord would not have been able to give us Himself in the Holy Eucharist if our Lady had not given him to us in the first place. Mary's role as mother of Jesus in the economy of salvation as laid out in God's plan, is indispensable. Not only does Mary, as mother, bring forth the Lord to the world, but also as the perfect disciple she shows us the way to follow him.

The month of May has long been dedicated to Mary - to honor her and to ask for her intercession. One of the best methods of doing both is to prayerfully recite the Rosary. Saints, popes, and holy people for generations have emphasized the value of the Rosary in bringing one closer to the Lord. At each critical stage of the Lord's life from the annunciation and birth, to the very beginning of Christ's public life initiated at his mother's behest at the wedding at Cana, to the very end of his public life as he is dying on the cross, his mother is present as an abiding presence in his life. Now in heaven she still abides with her son, our Lord, continuing her mission of bring the Lord to the world and leading the world to him. The Rosary helps to commemorate key events in the life of Christ and through our fruitful meditation on these saving events; we can through Mary's intercession, obtain the grace to live the kind of faithful discipleship that she lived. I enthusiastically urge everyone to pray the Rosary often, not just in May.

I especially encourage families to pray the rosary together. Although there might be a bit of awkwardness in the beginning, stick with it, for praying together as a family offers such tremendous spiritual benefits it is hard to overestimate.

Please come out and join our First Communicants after the 11:30AM Mass for our annual May Procession in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary!
