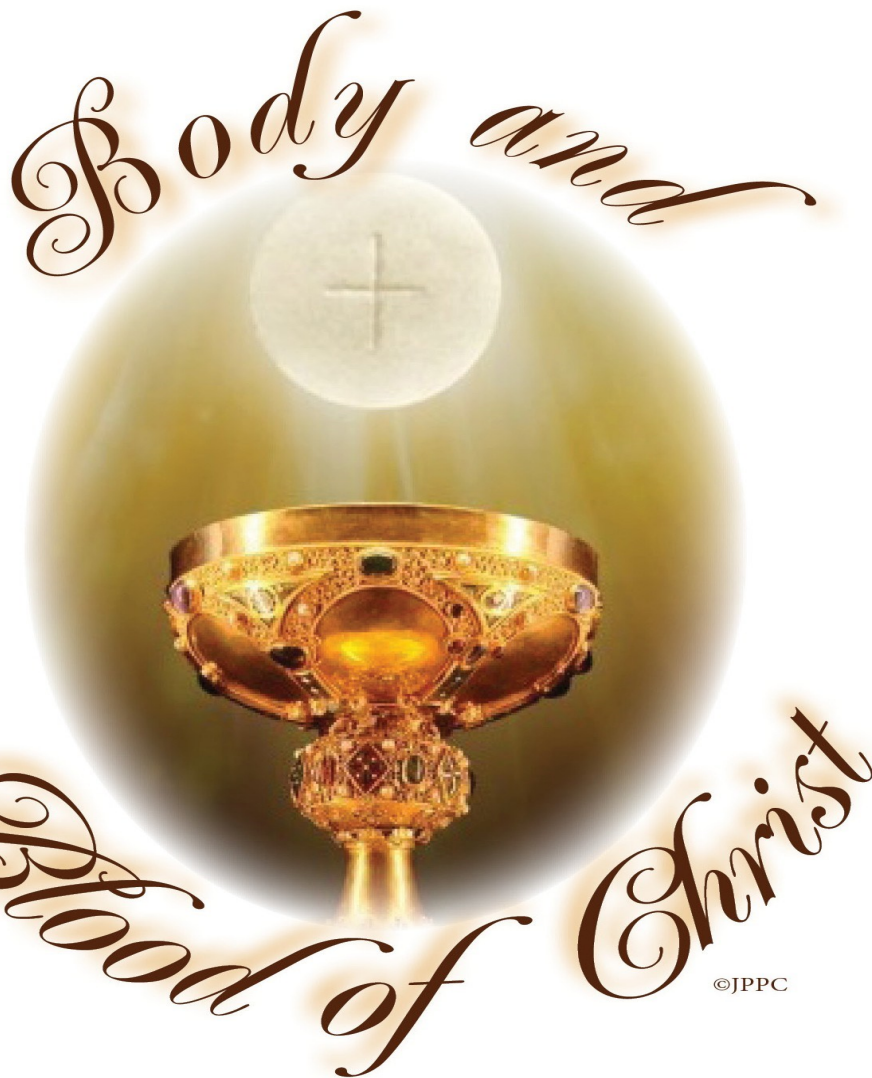

## Corpus Christi and Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration



Today is Feast of Corpus Domini – The Body and Blood of Christ. Our belief in the abiding True Presence (and not symbolic) of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist is a central component of the Catholic Faith. Every time we genuflect to the tabernacle in a church (and especially participating in a Eucharistic procession like we do today) we both testify to our personal faith in the reality of Jesus present in the Holy Eucharist as well as open our hearts to the Lord's grace to reinforce our faith in His Eucharistic Presence. Praying before the Lord in the tabernacle, or even better during Eucharistic Adoration, has been encouraged from the earliest time of the Church to help us develop and come closer to the Lord. During an audience Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI shared this beautiful address regarding the value of Eucharistic Adoration:

*Dear Brothers and Sisters!*

*Today's solemnity of Corpus Domini, which in the Vatican and other nations was already celebrated this past Thursday, invites us to contemplate the great mystery of our faith: the most holy Eucharist, the real presence of the Lord Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the altar.*

*Every time that the priest renews the Eucharistic sacrifice, in the prayer of consecration he repeats: "This is my body ... this is my blood." He does this giving his voice, his hands, and his heart to Christ, who wanted to remain with us as the beating heart of the Church. But even after the celebration of the divine mysteries, the Lord Jesus remains living in the tabernacle; because of this he is praised, especially by Eucharistic adoration.*

*Indeed, there is an intrinsic connection between celebration (of Mass) and adoration. The holy Mass, in fact, is in itself the Church's greatest act of adoration: "No one eats this food," St. Augustine writes, "if he has not first worshipped it". Adoration outside holy Mass prolongs and intensifies what happened in the liturgical celebration and renders a true and profound reception of Christ possible.*

*...In life today, which is often noisy and scattered, it is more important than ever to recover the capacity for interior silence and recollection: Eucharistic adoration permits one to do this not only within one's "I" but rather in the company of that "You" full of love who is Jesus Christ, "the God who is near us."*

*May the Virgin Mary, Eucharistic Woman, lead us into the secret of true adoration. Her heart, humble and silent, was always recollected around the mystery of Jesus, in whom she worshipped the presence of God and his redemptive love. By her intercession may there grow faith in the Eucharistic mystery, the joy of participating at holy Mass, especially on Sunday, and the desire to bear witness to the immense charity of Christ.*

Don't forget, we have Eucharistic Adoration Mondays at 7:00PM and on Fridays from 9:30AM-7:00PM. Come out and spend an hour with the Lord, it will be the best hour of your day!

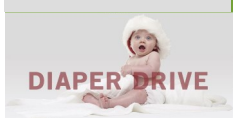

## MONTHLY BOOK STUDY: JULIAN OF NORWICH B. 1343

Julian is a fourteenth century mystic known for her positive theology written in her work: **The Revelation of Divine Love**. Many might be familiar with the writings of St. Faustina and her Chaplet of Divine Mercy, made popular by Pope St. John Paul II. Julian's work predates St. Faustina by 600 years.

Julian wrote in her Sixth Showing (or mystical vision):

*God's love for us is so great that it surpasses the understanding of any living being. Not a creature in all of creation can know how completely and how sweetly and with what infinite tenderness he loves us. Only with his grace and his assistance can we persevere in spiritual contemplation and maintain the awe and wonder that arise in our hearts in response to the soaring, transcendent, immeasurable love that the almighty God, in his goodness, has for us.*

**Join me in reading the writings of Juliana over the next few months.** We will meet once a month to discuss the assigned readings from her work. Her writings may give rise to questions, faith sharing and deeper insight into God's love for us and the beauty of our Christian life.

**We will have our first meeting on Thursday, June 30 at 7PM in the Parish Center classroom. We meet once a month.**

and freedom,

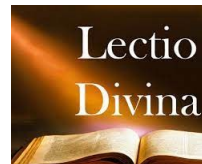

— PRAYING THE SCRIPTURES —

The Lectio Scripture Group that began during Lent will continue to meet monthly to pray with the Scriptures.

**Anyone interested in joining are most welcome.** The group will meet on the **Fourth Monday of each month, at 10AM in the basement of St. Patrick Church.**

Remember, Lectio is a spiritual practice of reading a Scripture and slowly extracting from it meaning for my life. Guido II (1114-1193), a Carthusian Monk, wrote of this practice and saw Lectio as a "four step ladder" that takes one to God. He directs us to read a text progressively, four times: **First reading: read the text. Second reading: meditate on the text, Third reading: pray on the text, Fourth reading: contemplate the text.** It is a practice of taking the text ever deeper into our daily lives. Come and learn.
