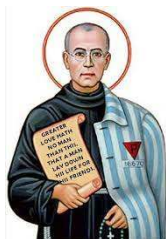

Saint Maximilian Kolbe

Saint Maximilian Kolbe was born in Poland on January 8, 1894. He became a Franciscan Friar and as a priest promoted devotion to the Blessed Mother. After spending time as a missionary in Japan he returned to his native Poland during World War II. He was soon imprisoned in the famous Auschwitz prison camp for continuing to promote the Catholic faith under Nazi occupation. His holy life was crowned with martyrdom when he offered to take the place of another prisoner who was going to be killed by starvation along with other prisoners in punishment for an attempted escape. His feast day is August 14th.

Saint Maximilian Kolbe had a brother who was also a priest and there exists a letter that Saint Maximilian Kolbe wrote to him. Its primary focus is on the virtue and nobility of obedience to superiors. Explaining that it was one of the principal examples of Christ who came to earth to do his Father's will he wrote about the importance of obedience.

In his letter he wrote, *"God, who is all knowing and all-wise, knows best what we should do to increase his glory. Through his representatives on earth he continually reveals his will to us; thus it is obedience and obedience alone that is the sure sign to us of the divine will. A superior may, it is true, make a mistake; but it is impossible for us to be mistaken in obeying a superior's command. The only exception to this rule is the case of a superior's commanding something that in even the slightest way would contravene God's law."* He continued later in this way, *"Obedience is the one and only way of wisdom and prudence for us to offer glory to God."*

While the context of this may have been one priest writing to another priest about obeying one's religious superiors, it certainly is fitting for all of us with regard to obedience to those who have legitimate authority over us. Obedience is a very difficult thing, humanly speaking. It is a great challenge for us to subject our will to another, especially if we don't agree. Yet, how can we not think of the Lord the night before his passion in the Garden of Gethsemane who prayed, "Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me, nevertheless, not as I will but as thou will." Jesus is our model and example. If we are truly his followers we need to follow him not only in other things but also in his obedience as well. We may not like what we are asked to do, or even agree with it, but we must know that we are still following God's will when we obey our legitimate superiors. In this is virtue and nobility. It is the way of Saint Maximilian Kolbe, and more importantly it is the way of our Lord Jesus Christ.

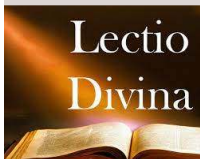

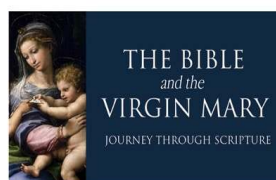
WATCH THE WOMAN

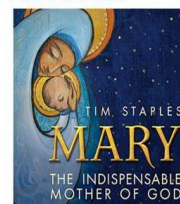

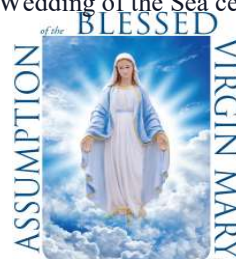

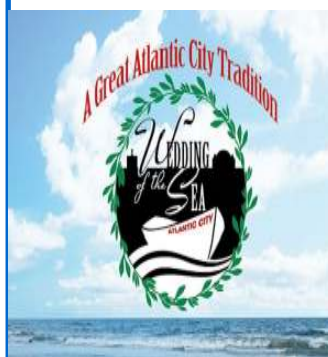
